Conference on behalf of the Agency should be based on the Charter and the relevant provisions of the Statute of the IAEA and of the United States should certainly remain in force.

The Secretary-General of the United Nations or his representative should be invited to attend and to participate without vote on matters of common interest

of the Agency and the Board of Governors. He should be invited as an observer to such other meetings of the Agency as

are relevant to the United Nations and under consideration of which

he should be entitled to attend and participate without vote. Representatives of the Agency and its committees, meetings of the Board of Governors, should vote in meetings of the General Conference of the Agency.

He may attend its meetings to supply it with information or give it other assistance with regard to matters within the competence of the Agency.

III. The Agency should include in the agendas of the General Conference or the Board of Governors items proposed by the United Nations. The Agency should have
