## 7. Conclusion

Over the duration of the Fund's operation from 2006 to 2014, 71 percent of expenditures was devoted to supporting Parties to the Agreement, participants in RFMO and global meetings. 21 percent was directed to capacity development, a very small percentage supported issues related to dispute settlement and 2 percent was for administrative and associated costs (Table 2).

The Assistance Fund was established and is being managed in accordance with its Terms of Reference and FAO's Financial Regulations and other applicable rules. The United Nations and FAO encourage States, intergovernmental organizations, international financial institutions, national institutions and non-governmental organizations, as well as individuals, to make voluntary contributions to the Fund. The United Nations and FAO seek to ensure that the Assistance Fund maintains a healthy funding level so that support for the implementation of the 1005
