Article 174<sup>35</sup>

The master of a ship, by displaying any distinguishing mark or insignia on the side of the ship as if it were a Surinamese war ship or state vessel or a pilot boat or an official ship of the Surinamese coast guard, is liable to a maximum fine of 1000 Surinamese dollars.
