Second, with respect to paragraph 3, we would have wished to see a clearer reference \pm drawing on more recent sources - to the Sustainable Development Goals and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The Declaration's text gives insufficient prominence to this point in the context of its reference to internationally agreed development goals.

Finally, as regards paragraph 4, we would note that we do not interpret this language as imposing any new financial obligations and that this text does not reflect relevant developments since 2014 - most importantly the Addis Ababa Action Agenda which provides the global framework for financing in support of the SDGs.
