




Decision taken by GMG Principals:



Asia Pacific Regional Preparatory Meeting for the High level Dialogue on International Migration and Development 2013

- RPM will take place 29 31 May, organized by the Asia Pacific RCM Thematic Working Group on International Migration including Human Trafficking
- RPM will consist of a general debate and 4 thematic roundtable sessions:
 - Ensuring respect and protection of the rights of all migrants and promoting legal and orderly labour migration;
 - Addressing the gender dimensions of international migration and their impact on women, children and families;
 - Assessing the effects of international migration on sustainable development and identifying relevant priorities;
 - Promoting regional cooperation and institutional coherence and partnerhsips in address international migration.
- RPM outcome document will serve as the key regional input to the HLD


