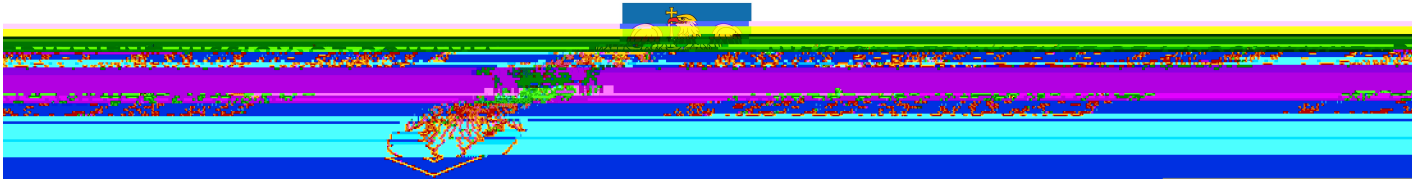


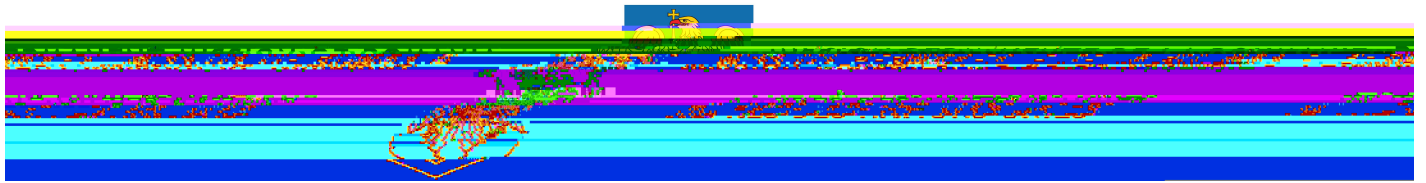


Cairo. In addition, a wide range of policies and programs have been developed in our country.
