Program for the Side Event on "Population Changes and Human Capital Development in China"

I. Background

In 2022, China's population embarked on a trajectory of negative growth, marking a new era of China's population and development. China will face a future where its birth rate continues to decline, adolescents and youth population shrink, proportion of working-age population decreases, and population ageing accelerates. Meanwhile, the educational attainments among the general population continue to improve and the rise in human capital provides new driving forces for China's social economic development. This however hinges largely on government's investments in the education and health for adolescents and youths, especially for women, and how the government will facilitate their entry into the labor market and ensure equal opportunities for both genders. With this in mind, a side event will be conducted on China's population changes and human capital development during the CPD56 taking advantage of its focus on "Population, education and sustainable development". The side event will present on the achievements China has made on population and development, potential of human capital development, and how such changes may contribute to the future world's development.
