Review of progress since 1994 based on ICPD regional conferences, CPD57 and other key moments

Key messages:

Significant progress in access to sexual and reproductive health and gender equality

programme implementation

Key

ODA is at record levels but remains below aid targets

Aid for population matters has increased in absolute terms but declined as a share of total ODA, and remains almost entirely allocated to SRH

Aid for infectious diseases has significantly increased, while aid for NCDs accounts for less than 1% of aid for health and does not reflect the changes in the demographic and epidemiological situation

As a result of insufficient domestic public investments, health expenditure in LICs has increasingly relied on ODA
