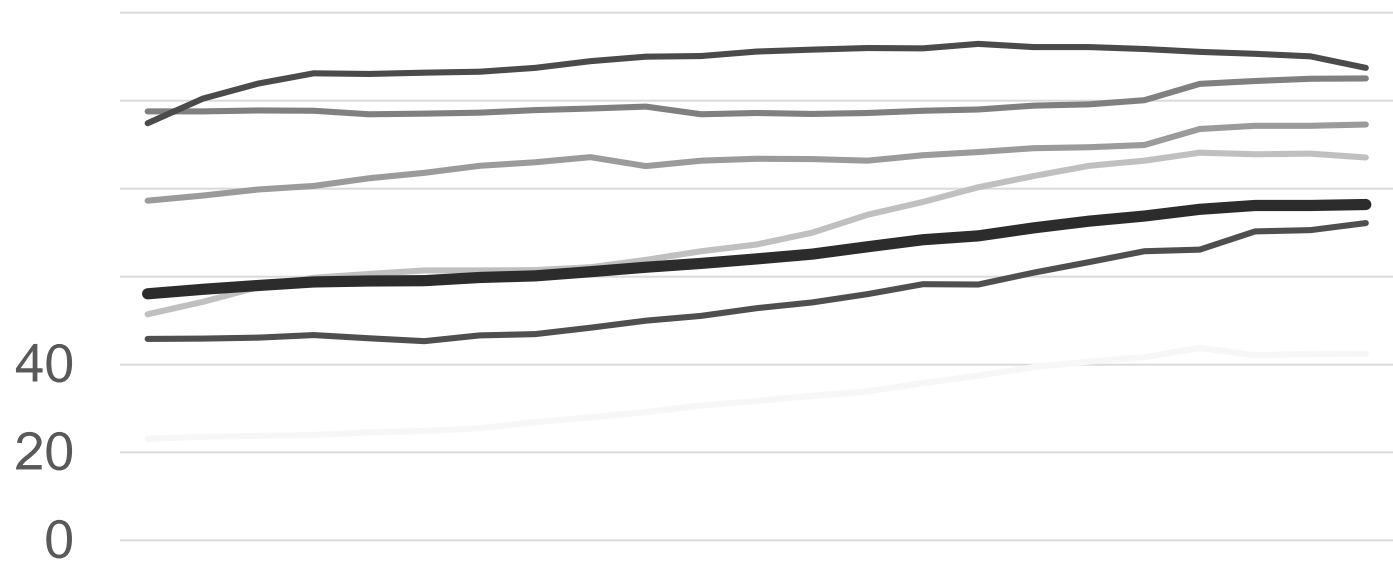

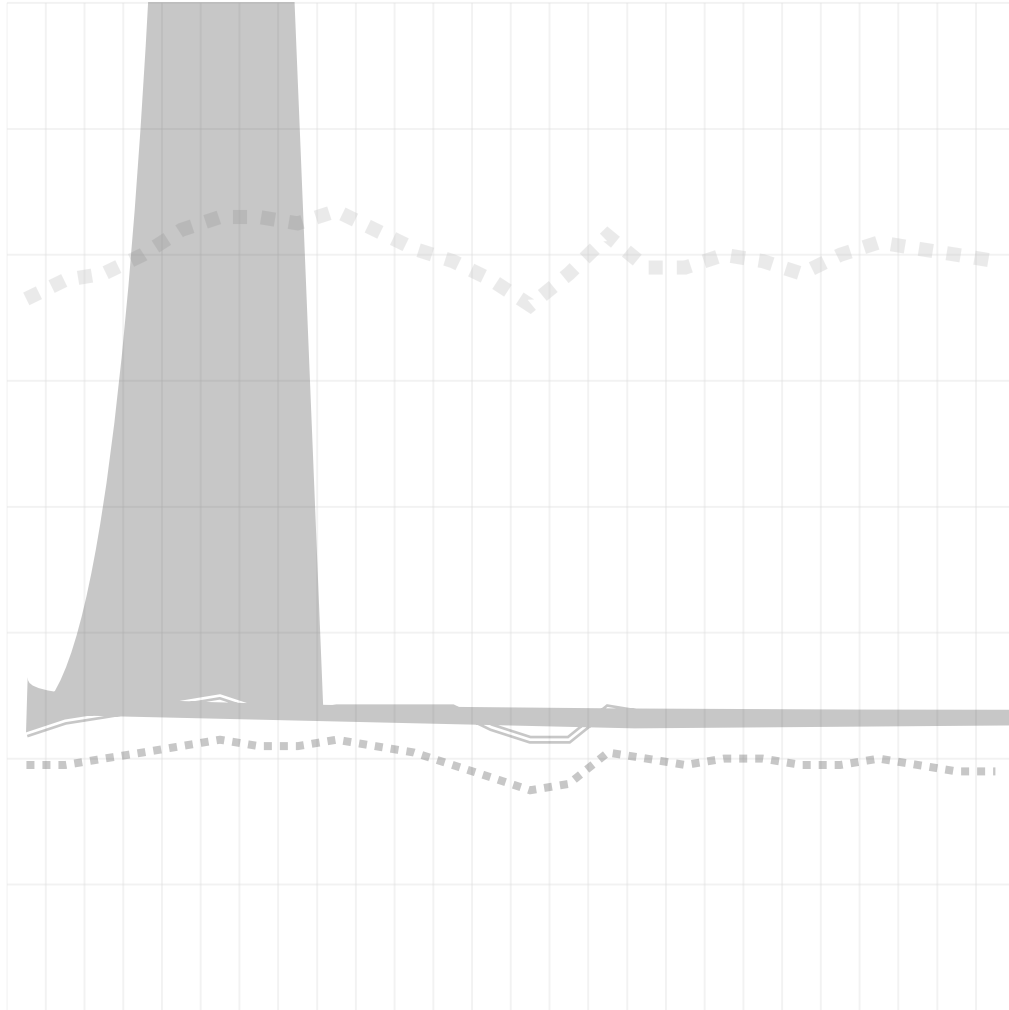
Backdrop: Wealth Inequalities continue to worsen

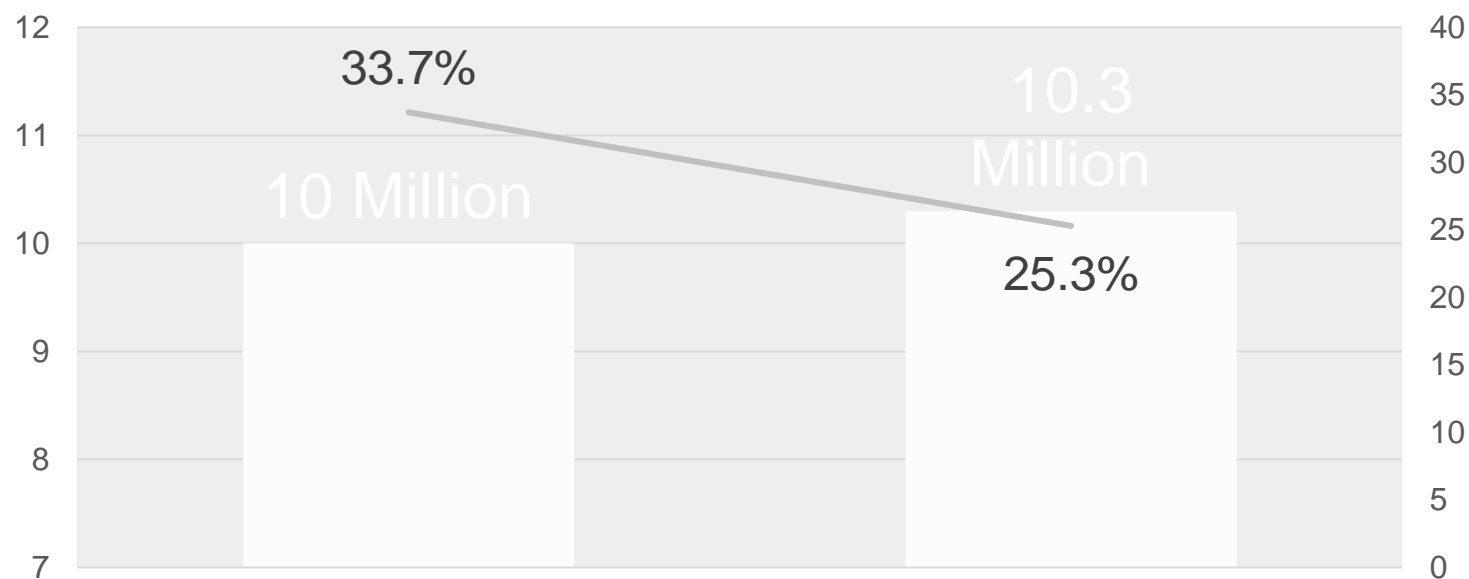

More Girls at Risk of Child Marriage

In 1994, 10 million girls got married before age 18

In 2019, 10.3 million girls will marry before age 18

Despite the decline in percentage from 33.7% to 25.3%.



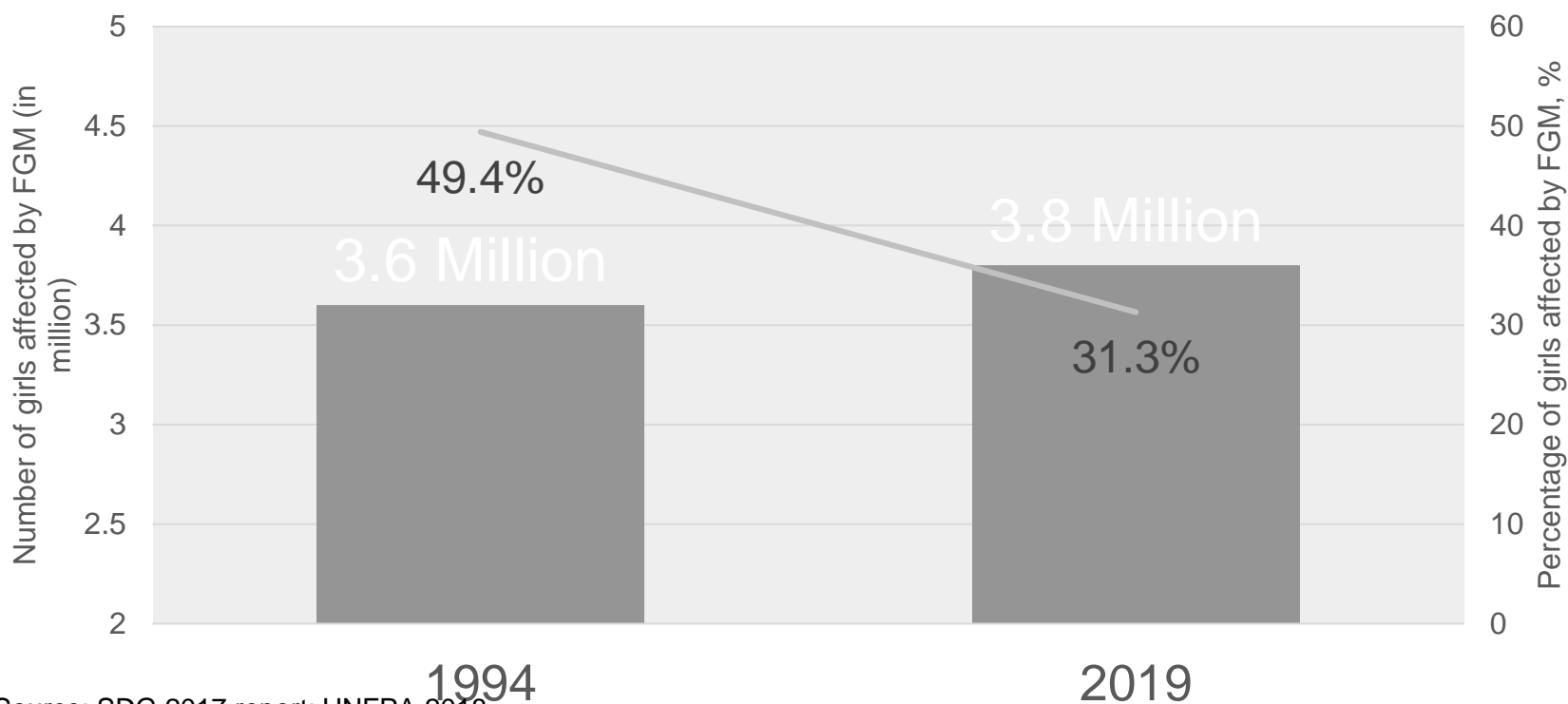

More girls will undergo FGM

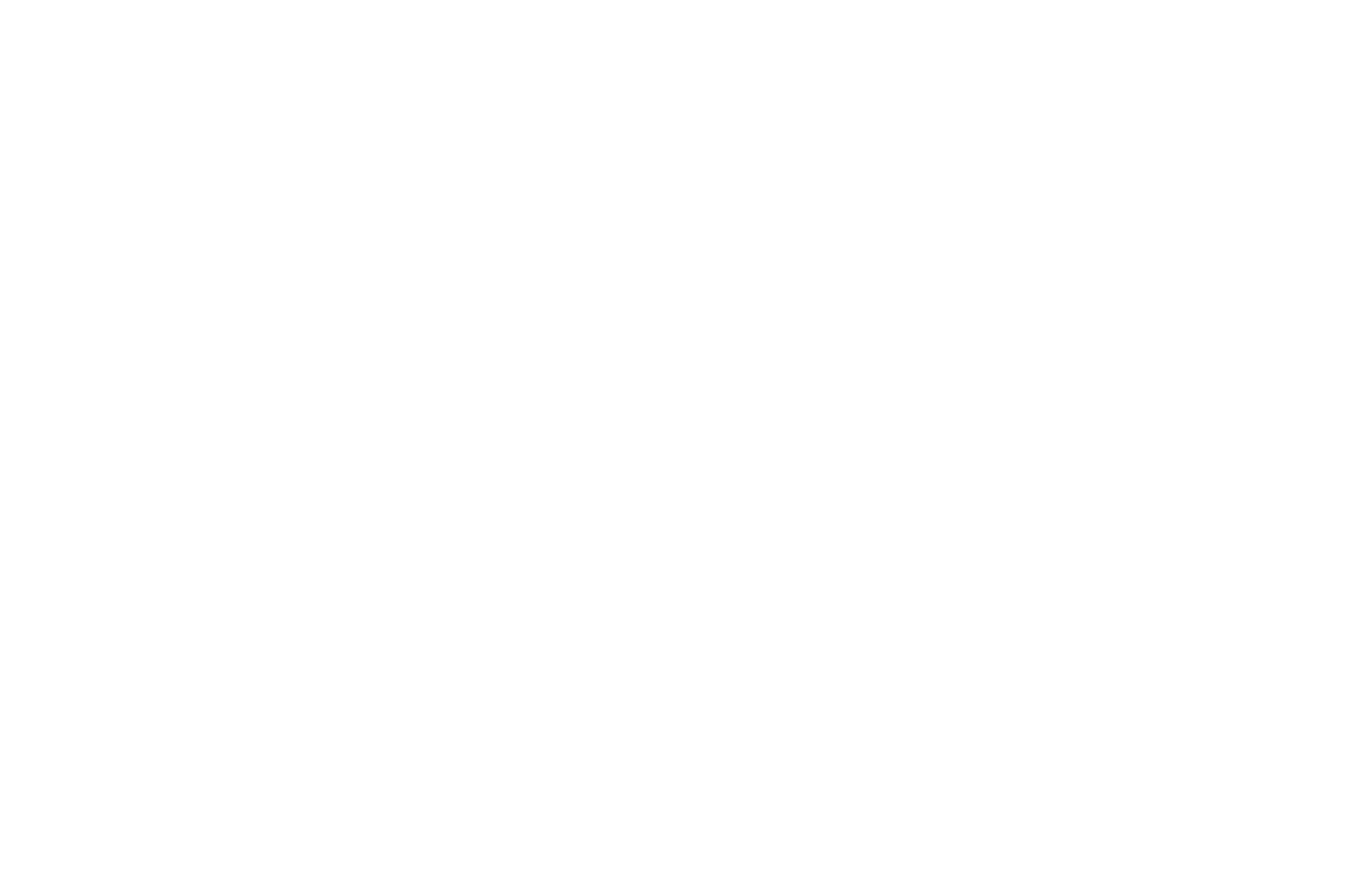
In 1994, 3.6 million girls age 15-19 had undergone FGM

In 2019, 3.8 million girls age 15-19 will have undergone FGM

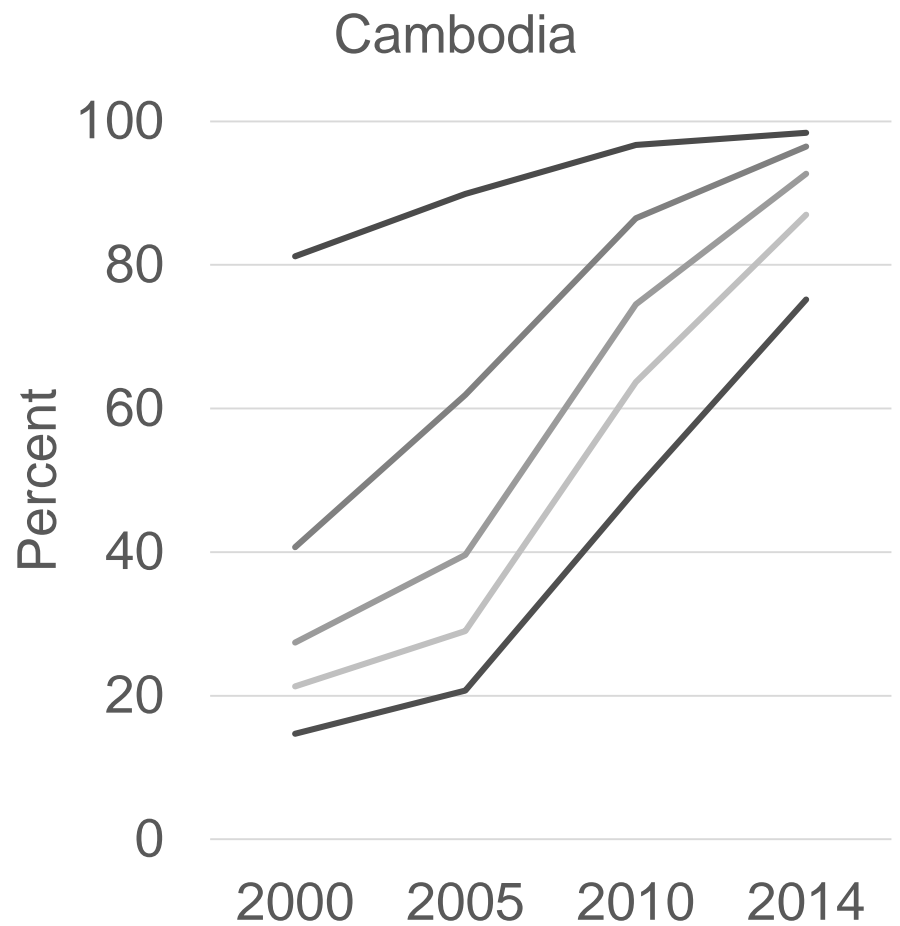
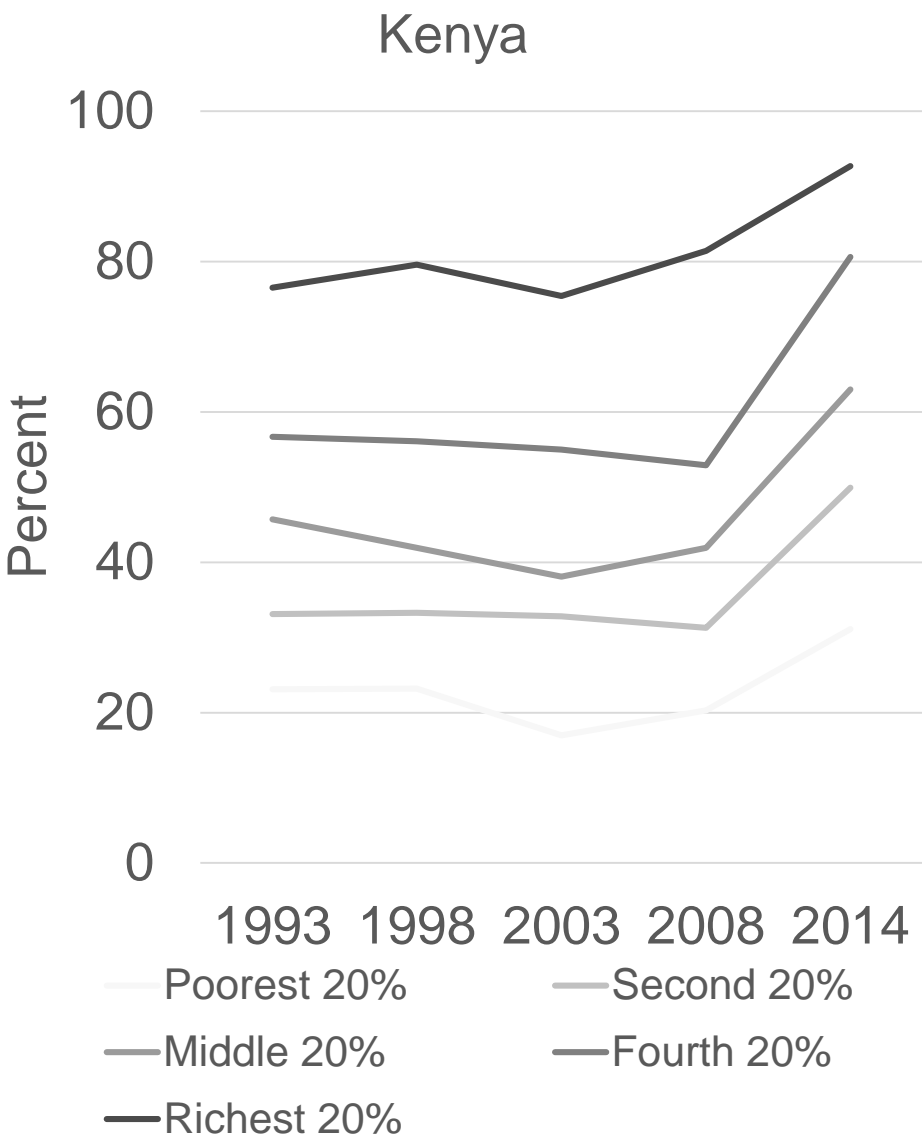
Despite a decline in percentage from 49.4% to 31.3%

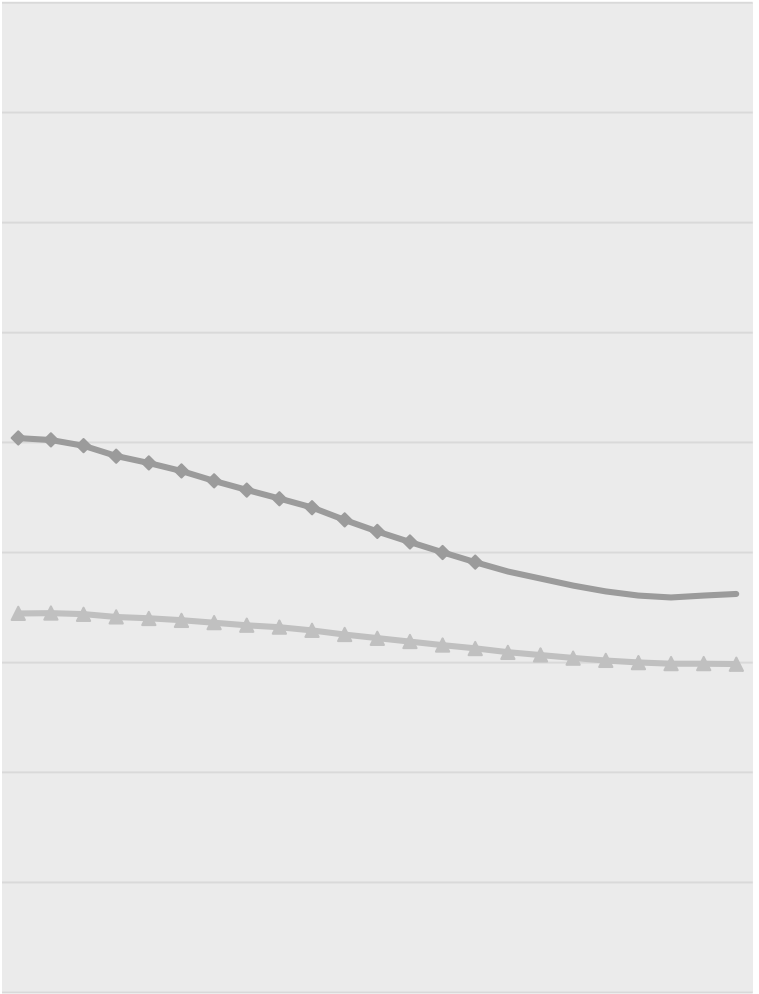


Trends in skilled attendance at birth by household wealth quintiles
