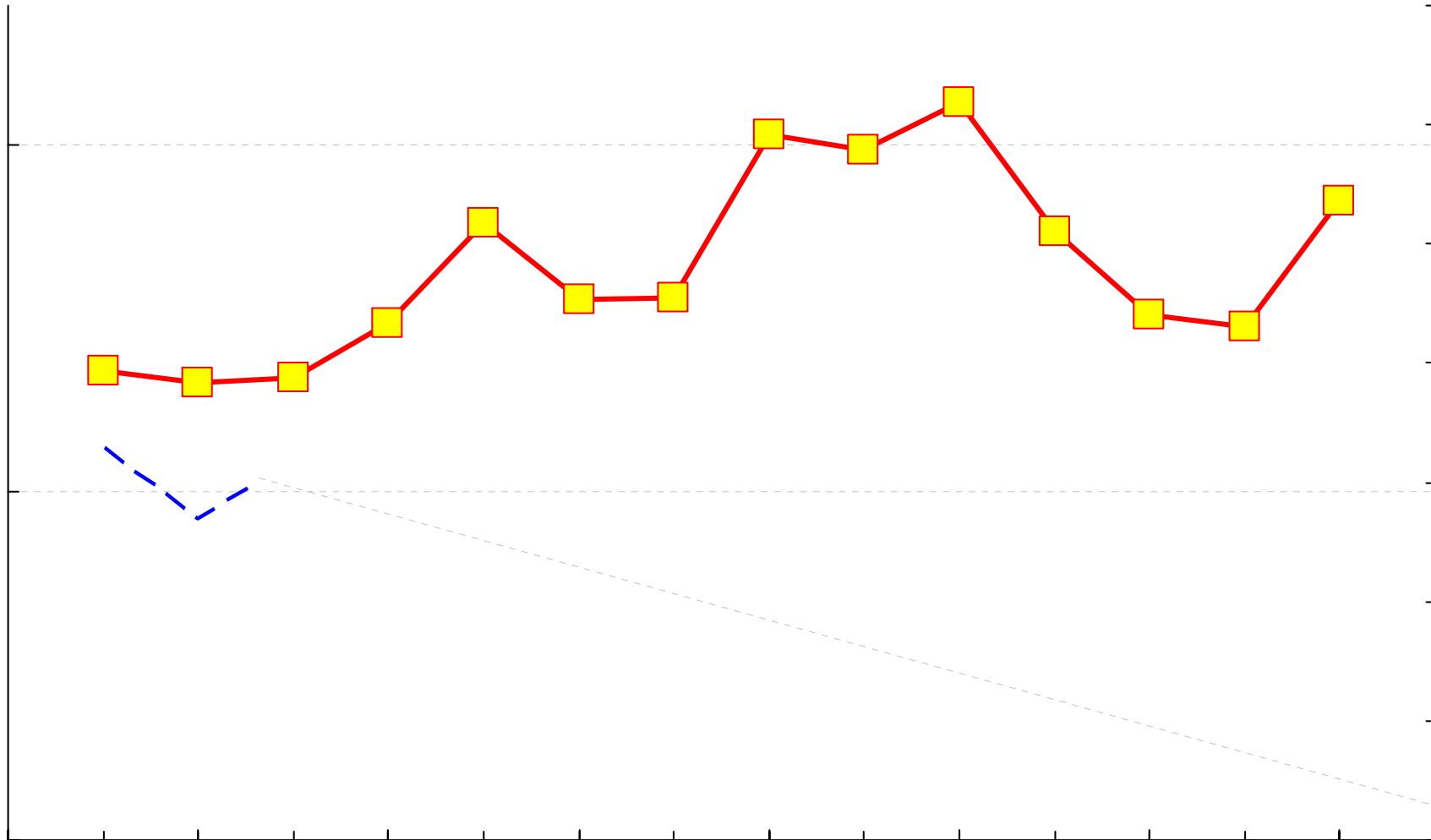








# ***Mexican Migration Follows Trends in U.S. Employment Rate***





























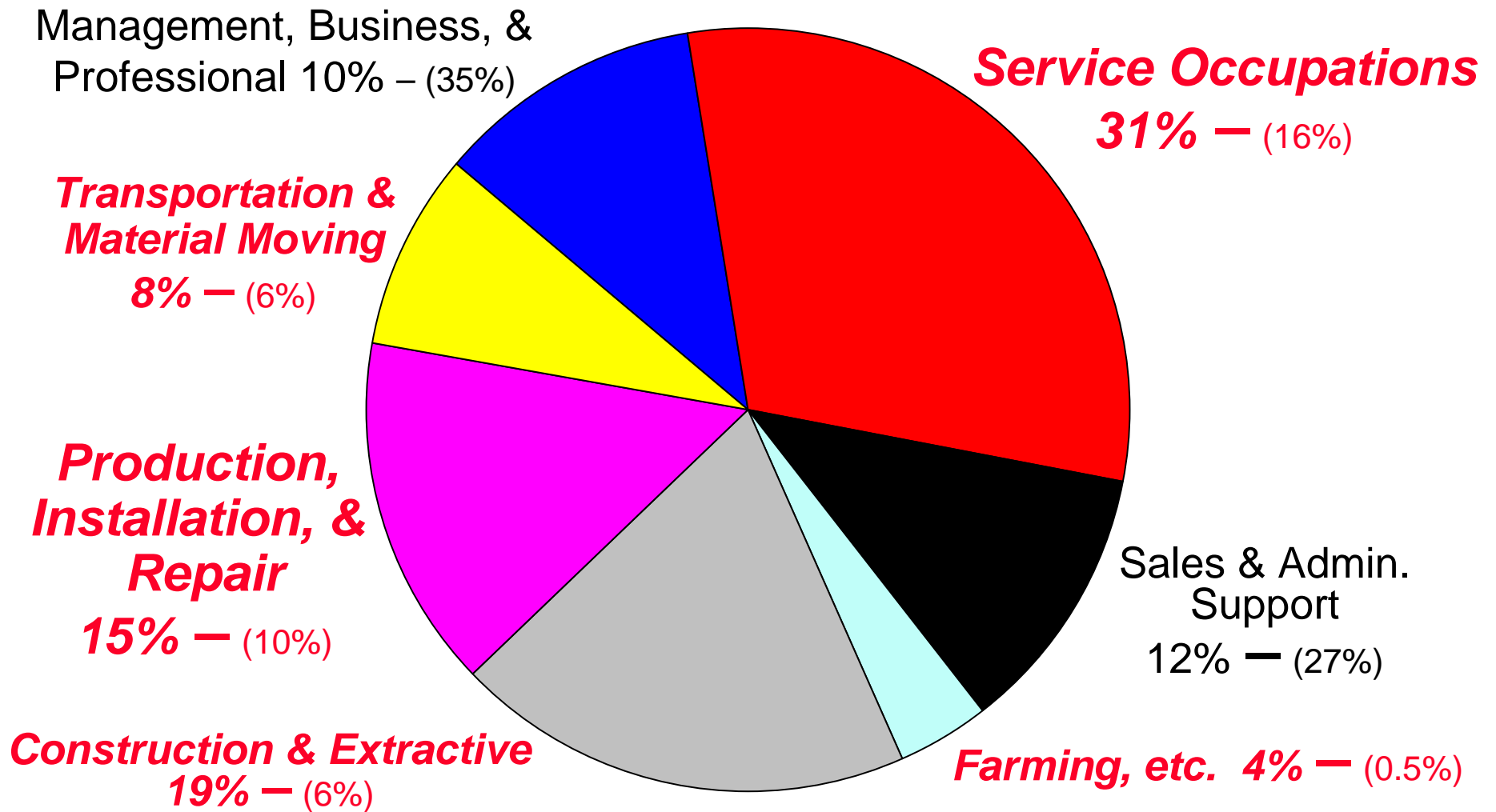








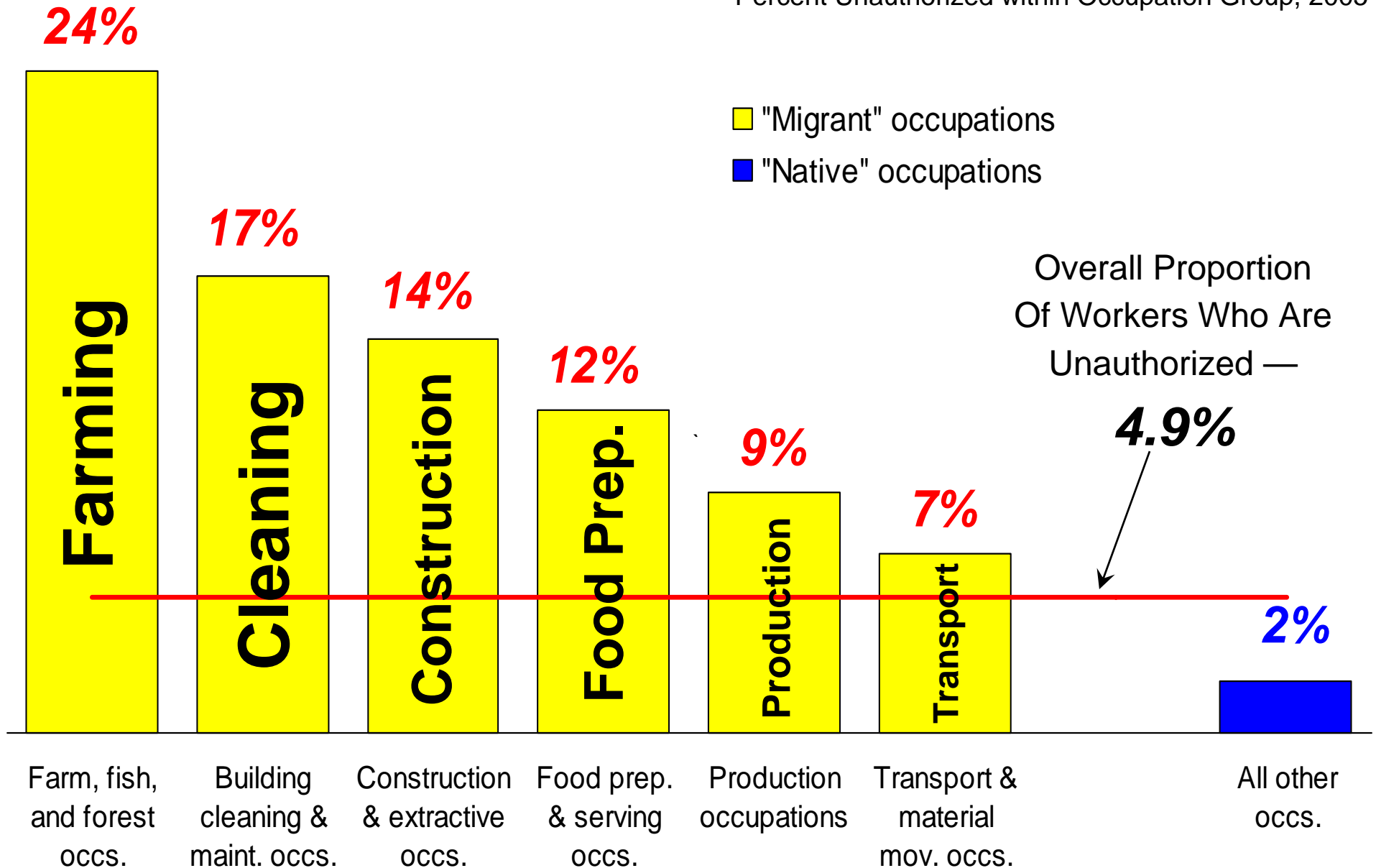
# Unauthorized in Lower Wage & Education Occupations



**7.2 Million Unauthorized Workers, 2005**

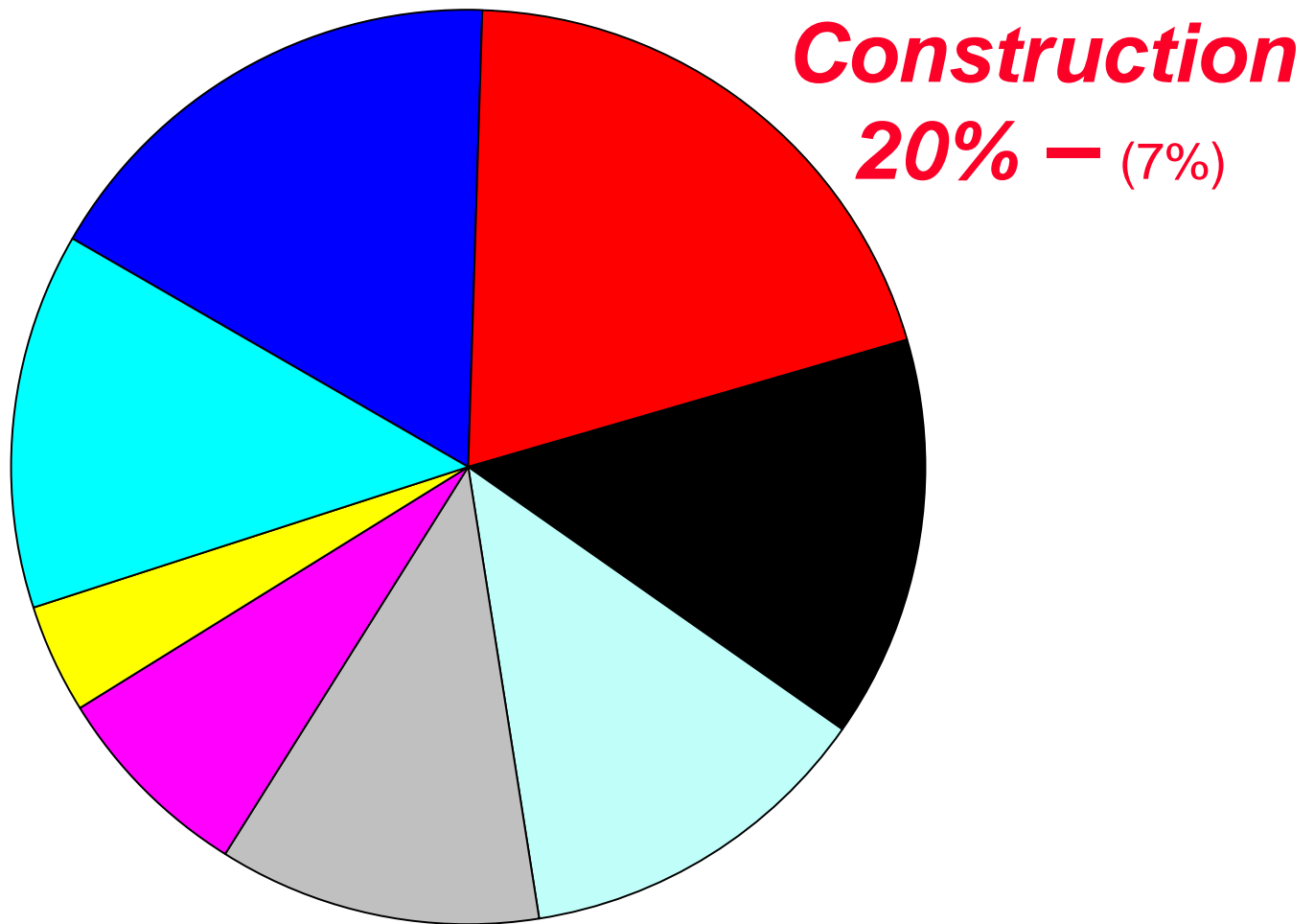
# Most Concentrated Occupations

Percent Unauthorized within Occupation Group, 2005



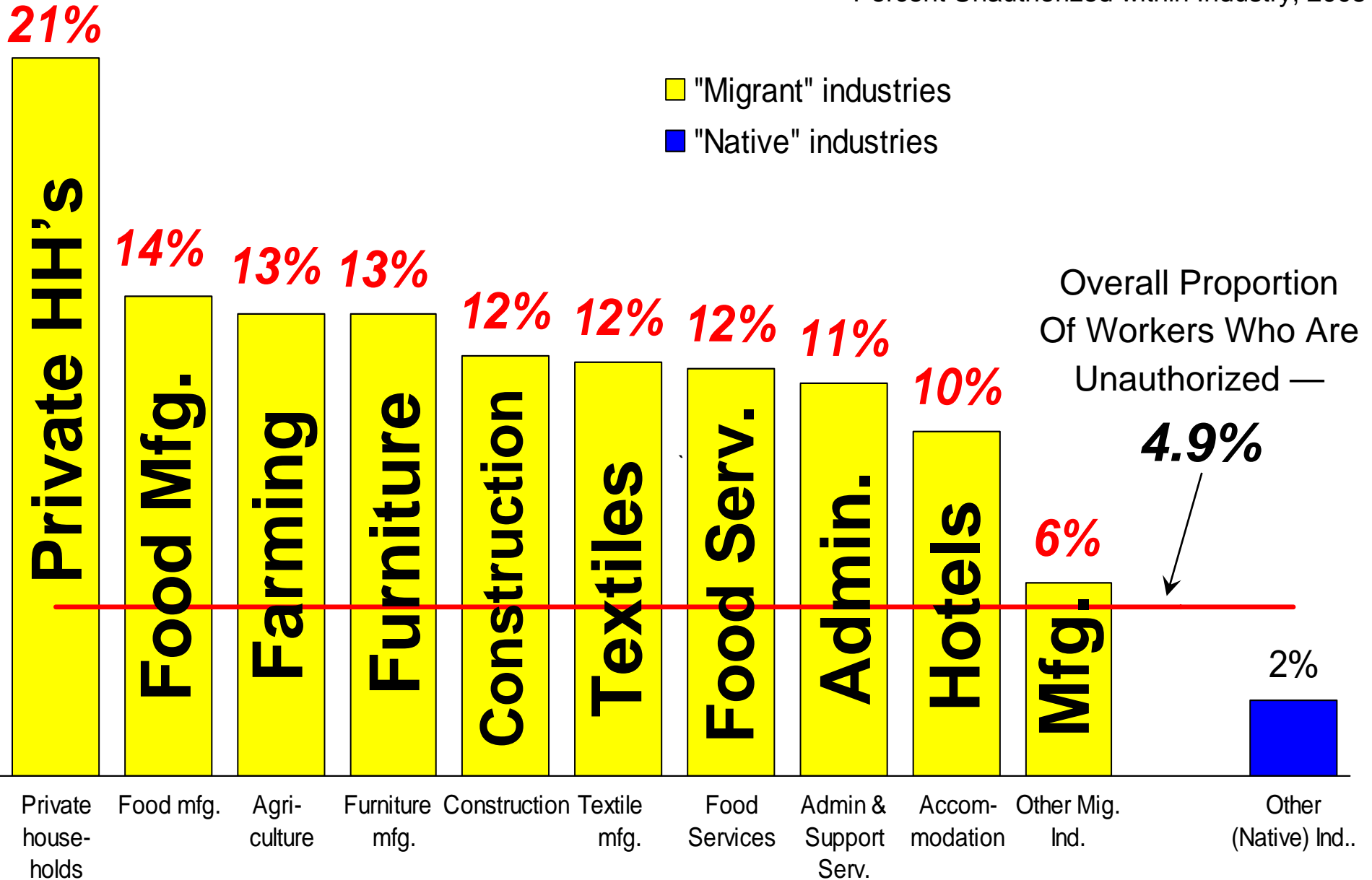


# ***Unauthorized Over-Represented in a Few Industries***
