





Factors which contribute to comprehensive migration policy.

- A lead government agency which streamlines migration into all relevant policy areas (Canada, Costa Rica)
- Transparency

 across all domains of migration governance
 (e.g. having dear information about laws and publidy available data (South Korea, Sweden))
- Blateral/Regional/International collaboration
 on issues such as work visas and repatriation (The Philippines, Italy)


