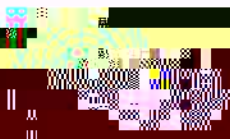

Conciliation

ARTICLE 10
CONCILIATION

1. In the event of a dispute arising out of this MOU, the Parties shall first attempt to resolve the dispute through conciliation.

ARTICLE 11
DISPUTE RESOLUTION

1. In the event of a dispute arising out of this MOU, the Parties shall first attempt to resolve the dispute through conciliation. If the dispute is not resolved through conciliation, the Parties shall refer the dispute to the Arbitration Tribunal established under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

2. The Arbitration Tribunal shall be constituted by the Parties.

ARTICLE 12
FORCE MAJEURE

1. Notwithstanding to anything herein contained, this MOU shall remain in force and effect notwithstanding any breach, termination, or invalidity thereof. Where the Parties wish to seek such an amicable settlement through conciliation, they shall be bound to do so in accordance with the Conciliation Rules of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
