2. The Conference elected Mr. Enrique Roman-Morey (Peru) as the Chair of the Committee, and Mr. Henk Cor van der Kwast (Netherlands) and Mr. Andrej Logar (Slovenia) as Vice-Chairpersons of the Committee.

Establishment of Subsidiary Body 1

3. At its eighth plenary meeting, on 30 April 2015, the Conference decided to establish, for the duration of the 2015 Review Conference, a Subsidiary Body 1 under Main Committee I, chaired by Mr. Benno Laggner (Switzerland). The Conference further decided that Subsidiary Body 1 would examine "Nuclear disarmament and security assurances". Furthermore, the Conference decided that Subsidiary Body 1 would be open-ended, that it would hold at least four meetings within the overall time allocated to the Main Committee, that its meetings would be held in private and that the outcome of its work would be reflected in the report of Main Committee I to the Conference.
