My delegation also wishes to reaffirm the understanding that Article IV of the Treaty vests States Parties with the inalienable right to develop research, production and use of nuclear energy as well as the right to participate to the fullest possible exchange of equipment, materials and technology for peaceful purposes in conformity

with respective safeguard agreements. In this regard, Malaysia remains perplexed why States outside of the NPT have enjoyed such rights. The international community
