**STATEMENT OF THE MEXICAN DELEGATION, DURING THE MAIN COMMITTEE II
OF THE IX REVIEW CONFERENCE OF THE PARTIES TO THE TREATY ON THE NON-
PROLIFERATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS**

Mr. President,

Mexico considers that while militarily denuclearized zones are not an end in themselves, they represent an intermediate step of great importance for making progress towards the

conclusion of general and complete disarmament under effective international control.

Mexico maintains that the negotiation of fissile material treaty for the fabrication of nuclear weapons and other explosive nuclear devices should be seen as part of a broad and

comprehensive process of nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation and considers it

necessary that such instrument provides elements such as the regulation of existing fissile material, a verification mechanism and confidence building measures. While there are several draft texts for the instrument, Mexico considers that these should be considered as a basis for negotiation without limiting the discussion and the analysis of other proposals
