

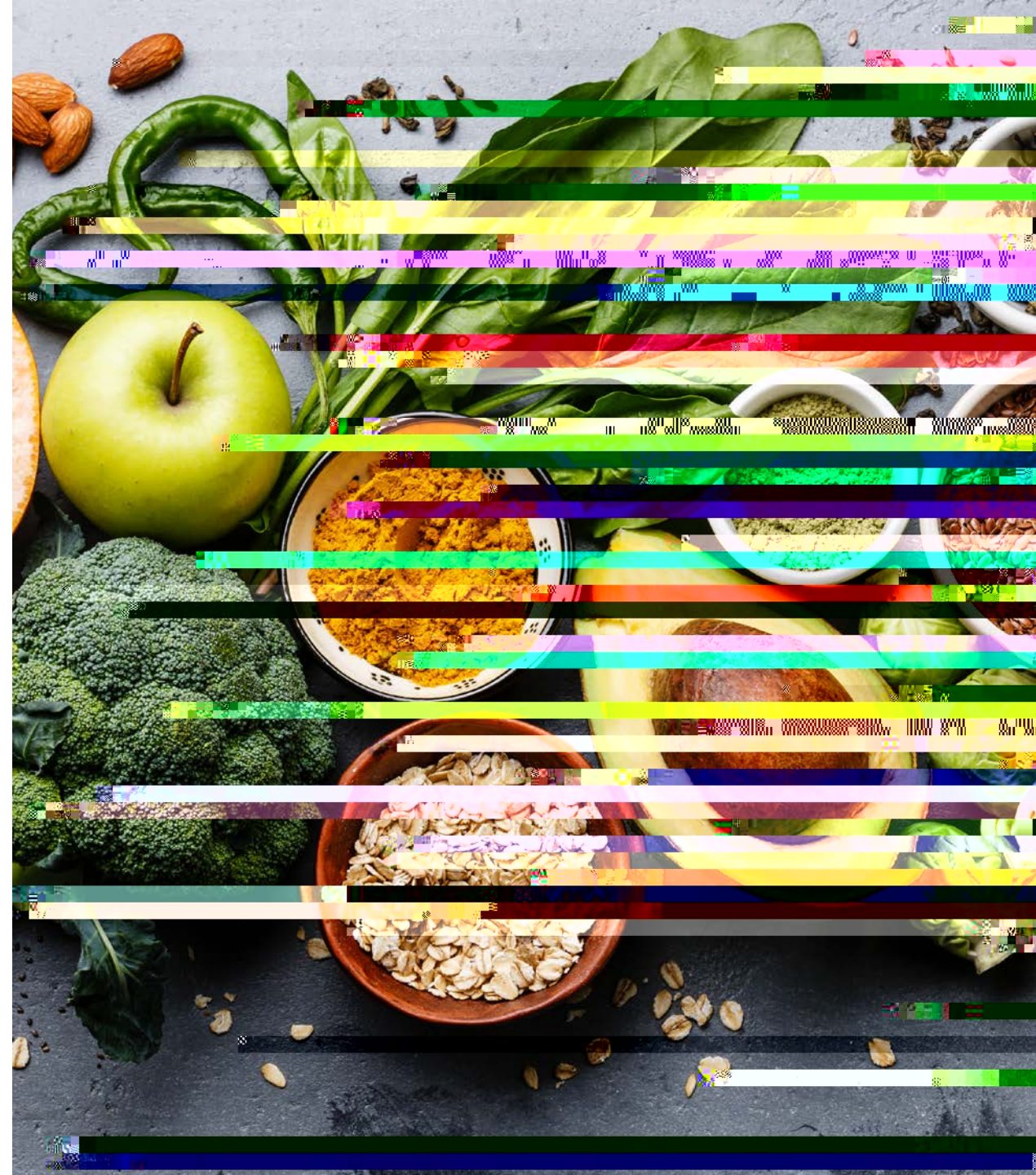

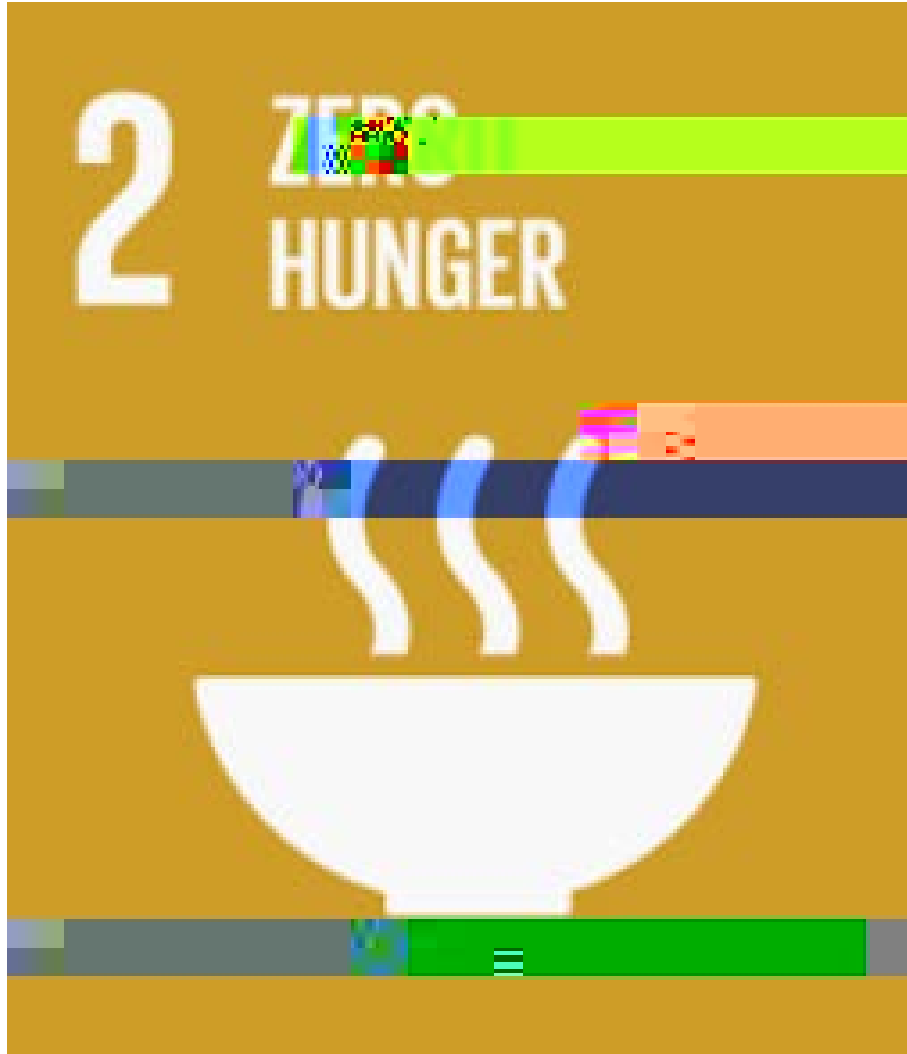

Hunger and malnutrition in all its forms

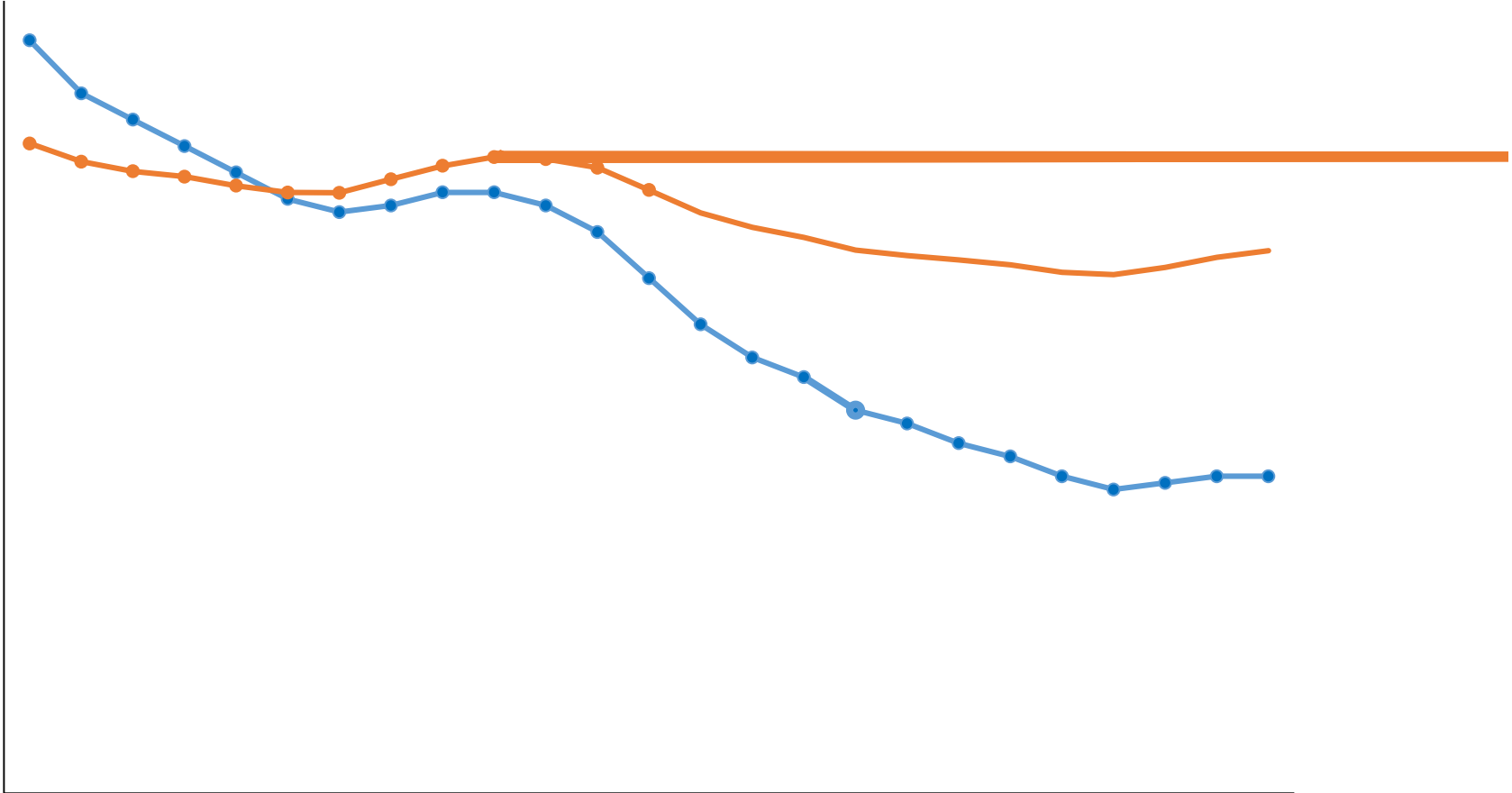

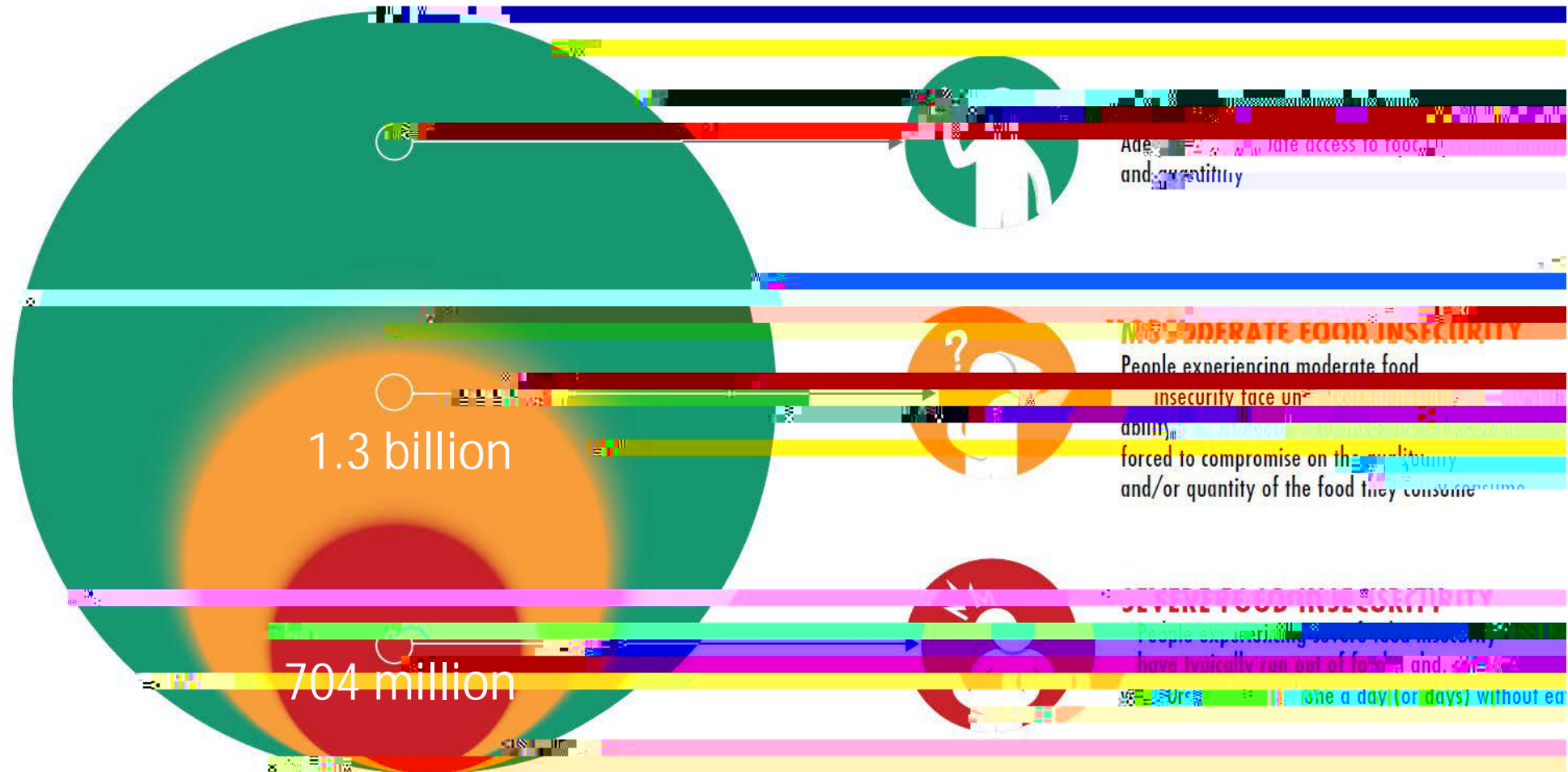


- Target 2.1 – “ensure access by all people [...] to safe, nutritious, and sufficient food all year round”

Prevalence of Moderate or Severe Food Insecurity

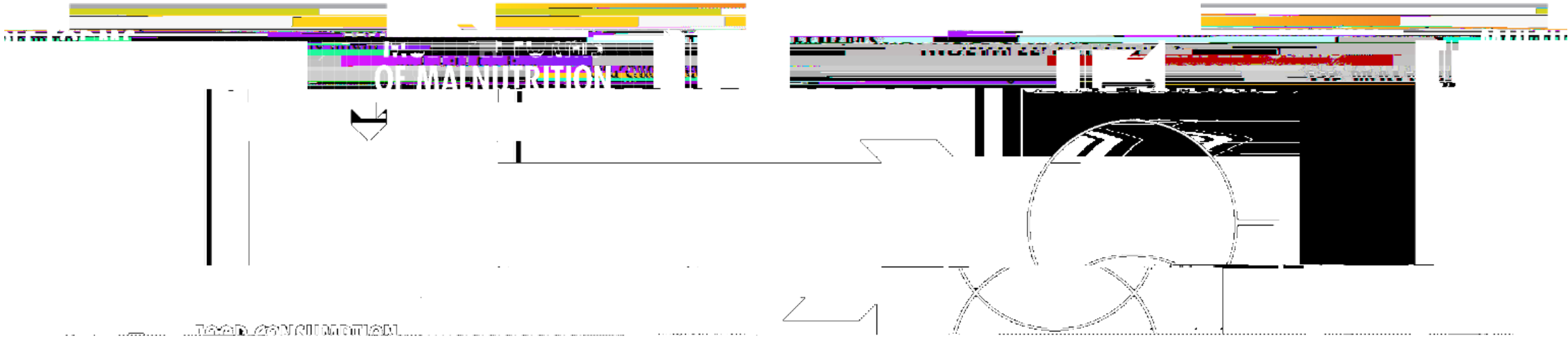


Food Insecurity, Hunger, and Malnutrition
