An initial draft of the national report is the main input for threational consultations NVP countries hold consultative dialogues, in the case of programme countries, national workshops undertake multistakeholder reviews. Such national consultations attimeontribute to improving public and intragovernmental debate on issues relating to the implementation of threetenment strategy and prioritysetting in pursuit of sustainable development objectives.

National consultations assist countries in assessirprogress towards their development objectives and the implementation of their national development attrategies with the broad participation of key stakeholders. Participants should policy makers, government representatives and representatives from the non-state sectors, such as third has and academia, civil society and the private sector. Such broad participation facilitate agreement and ownership, the identification of successes and gaps and contribute sharpening policy recommendations. eTh workshops can also be used to assess national best practices and lessons learned.
