Onstaffing the Committee roted that as a result of the requirment restrictions imposed in October in response to the liquidity axis is the vacancy rates by duty station in key compational groups has increased, particularly in the translation services in New York

The Committee requested the Secretary General to continue to make efforts to consule that multilingualism, as a furthmental value of the Organization, is not under mined by the measures in response to the liquidity crisis, as well as by the COVID 19 pandanic.

The Committee supported the memoranthms of understanding with education institutions as a way to strengthen the training of language professionals in order to facilitate the recruitment of qualified language staff and, as each inved in the General Assembly resolutions on multilingualism, highlighted the importance of giving equal treatment and an equally favourable working conditions and resources to all language services.

On the improvement of facilities and accessibility, the Committee on Conferences welconsol the measures related to conference services for persons with disabilities and requested the Secretary General to continue to achiese those issues as a priority.
