



(b) *Decides* to maintain the current time limits of 7 minutes for individual Member States and 10 minutes for delegations speaking on behalf of a group of States during the general debate, and urged delegations to adhere to those time limits;

(c) *Encourages* the Chair of the Committee to continue the practice of providing a summary of the general debate of the Committee.

4. With regard to debates on individual agenda items of the Second Committee:

(a) *Decides* to maintain debates on individual agenda items, while bearing in mind the need to avoid unnecessary duplications and overlaps in statements;

(b) *Decides* to restrict the number of panel discussions and side events to a maximum of 6 at each session of the Committee in order to avoid overloading its work;

(c) *Emphasizes* the importance of ensuring, inter alia, a variety of perspectives and appropriate geographic and gender balance in the selection of keynote speakers and panelists for panel discussions and side events.

7. *Reaffirms* the need to implement paragraph 9 of Part B of the Annex to its resolution 58/126, which, inter alia, stipulates that "the full Bureaux of the Main Committees shall be elected three months in advance of the next session" in order to foster better advance planning and preparation of the work;

8. *Decides* to continue its efforts to improve its working methods, including the rationalization of its agenda as requested in General Assembly resolutions 60/286 and 64/301 within the framework of the existing agenda item on the "Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly".
