**Measures to implement the Geneva Conventions of 1949 and the Additional Protocols  
thereto**

The Republic of Belarus attaches great importance to the implementation of international humanitarian law. Implementation efforts cover several areas:

- The improvement of national law and of law-enforcement practice;
- Accession to international treaties on international humanitarian law that develop the provisions of the Geneva Conventions and the Additional Protocols thereto;
- Dissemination of knowledge about international humanitarian law, study of practice

The commission has participated in the drafting of resolutions of the International

Conference of the Red Cross and Red Crescent. Specifically, the Belarusian delegation to the thirty-second International Conference of the Red Cross and Red Crescent (Geneva, 8-10 December 2015) communicated its position at the time of adoption of the resolutions at the Conference, including on the issues of strengthening international humanitarian law protecting persons deprived of their liberty, strengthening compliance with international humanitarian law
