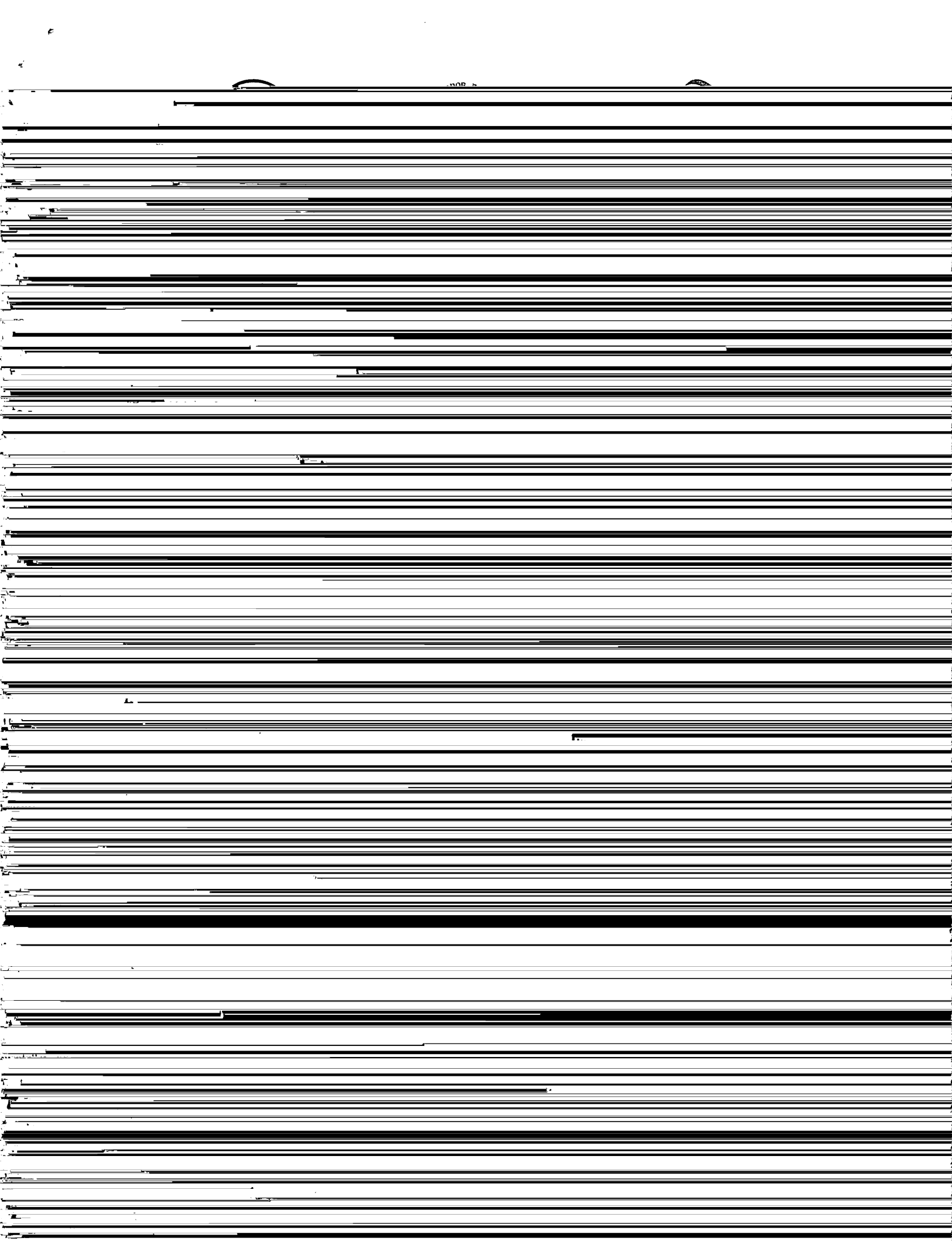

Finally, during the past three sessions, Member States decided to finance the activities of

the Assistance Program with regular budget provisions, including: The International Law Scholarship Program, the United Nations Regional Courses in International Law for Africa, Asia and the Pacific and Latin America and the Caribbean; the United Nations Audiovisual Library for International Law; as well as the Hamilton Shirley Amerasinghe Memorial on the Law of the Sea, in case voluntary contributions for the grant of one scholarship per

year were insufficient
