General overview of the progress made on this publication

Concerning the backlog, the Codification Division of the Office of Legal Affairs, acting as coordinator for the preparation of the publication, sought to significantly reduce the **backlog in volume III** of **Supplements Nos. 7 to 9** (1985-1999) of the *Repertory*. Research and drafting of a study on Article 23 of the Charter for volume III of these Supplements, is under preparation with the assistance of Peking University. Two previously completed studies one on Article 33 of the Charter, prepared with the assistance of interns in the Codification Division, and one on Article 49 of the Charter, prepared with the assistance of a consultant have been submitted for final review to the responsible author departments, namely, the Department of Political Affairs and the Department of Peacekeeping Operations, respectively.

Progress has also been made in the preparation of studies for volumes III and IV of **Supplement No. 10 (2000 2009)**. A study on Article 49 of the Charter for volume III, prepared with the assistance of a consultant, has been submitted to the responsible author department, the Department of Peacekeeping Operations, for final review. Two studies, on Articles 55 (c) and 56 for volume IV, are also currently under review by the responsible author department, the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights.
