As it was su""ested in 3<75 that further clarification is re\*uired etween o li"ations erga omnes and its relation to jus cogens norms, Estonia supports the analysis provided in para raph 3 and 9 of the Commentary to the &raft Conclusion 7;! It offers a clear distinction etween the fact that all jus cogens norms vive rise to o li ations erga omnes, however not all o li ations erga omnes have jus cogens nature!

Estonia supports the &raft Conclusion 37 and that it has een rou"ht in accordance with Articles 4> and 4; of the 7848 =ienna Convention! / owever, Estonia su""ests to approach this \*uestion somewhat cautiously ecause as the :ara"raph 6 of the Commentary to the &raft Conclusion explains? it aims to find a alance etween not imposin" treaty rules on \$tates that are not ound y such rules and takin" into account the need to avoid unilateral invalidation of rules!

Estonia welcomes the extensive work reflected in the non0exhaustive list of &raft Conclusion 39 and the added Annex! Estonia elieves that such analysis is vital for further discussions on jus cogens and for further evaluation on how international law is developin"!
