Since its establishment in 1971, the Committee remains an open, transparent, and flexible body where any interested delegation can participate in it as an observer. Moreover, the Committee is the

only body in the UN system which is mandated to consider matters in relation to the host country and then report thereon to the General Assembly and make recommendations.
