Georgia remains fully committed to fighting against terrorism and violent extremism, which in allits forms and manifestationsconstitutes one of the biggest threats to the international peace and securityOver the years, Georgia has made significant contribution to eradicate international terrorism cluding participation in peadeeping missions overeas. The Government of Georgia has been actively working to detect continuously transforming landscape of terrorism and to develop efficient, coherent and coordinated ways of responding to them.

In this regard, at me recall some recentlevelopments At the national level Georgiahas taken significant steps to establish unterterrorism Strategic Document. On 25 January 2022, the Government of Georgia approved the National Counterterrorism Strategy of Georgia (the second policy document of Georgia its Action Plan for 2022026, which were elaborated with the initiative and leadership of the State Security Service of Georgia (SSSG), as well as with the engagement of all other relevant state authorities.

The National Counterterrorism Strategy of Georgia defines the full range of terrorist threats that Georgia has to respond to anims at establishing the vision of the state in terms of prevention and the fight against terrorism and extremism. The documsent based upon the whole-society approach and various stakeholders including central and local authorities, publi-private organization, sas well as civil society are engaged in the implementation process.

Prevention of radicalization and violent extremism conducive to terrorism remains one of the main priorities for Georgia.

In order to effectively implement national strategy on terrorism in the context of Countering Violent Extremism (CVE), upon the attitute of the Permanent Interagency Commission and in cooperation with civil sector and with the assistance of Georgian Center for Strategy and Development (GCSD), the permanent purbliste dialogue platform was established. The platform comprises landoecement agencies, state agencies responsible for education, culture, health care, economy, as well as the representatives of NGOs and CSOs operating in the field of security and human rights protection. The dialogue platform holds regular meetings on the security and the security and human rights protection.
