In this regard, Argentina has organized in 2017 and participated in 2019 in International Conferences on Safety and Security of Cultural Property during Armed Conflicts, among which the "Development of the National Plan for the Protection of Cultural Heritage during Armed Conflicts" was presented. The Conference also emphasized the importance of international cooperation, particularly between countries and their cultural and educational institutions, and the need to establish mechanisms for the protection of cultural heritage during armed conflicts.
