1. I have the honour, once again, to address the Sixth Committee to report on the work of the fifty-eighth session of the Advisory Committee on the *Un*

The Secretariat informed the Committee of the publication of the second edition of volume 25 of the *United Nations Legislative Series*; volume 26 of the *United Nations Legislative Series*; the 10th edition of *The Work of the International Law Commission*; and the *Summaries of Judgments, Advisory Opinions and Orders of the International Court of Justice* for the years 2018 to 2022.
11. It was also noted that the Hamilton Shirley Amerasinghe Memorial Fellowship on the Law of the Sea awarded in 2020 and postponed due to restrictions imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic has now been undertaken.
12. Recommendations were also made for continuing cooperation with other regional international law institutions in respect of the activities outlined under the Programme of Assistance.
13. The Committee remained satisfied with the funding of the activities of the Programme from the regular budget of the Organization and stressed the need for additional voluntary contributions to support expansion and enhancement efforts. In this respect, I wish to re-
