### Event description

This high-level roundtable is organized in conjunction with the 79<sup>th</sup> session of the United Nations Sixth Committee (Legal). The 79<sup>th</sup> session follows the first UN General Assembly high-level meeting on sea level rise held on September 25, 2024, AOSIS Declaration on sea level rise and statehood of 23 September 2024 (W.K.H. 3 D.F.L.I.L.F., V.O.D.Q.G.) R.U.X.P.V. G.H.F.O.D.U.D.W.L.R.Q.V. R.I. zones and the continuity of statehood and the International Law Association (ILA) completion of its work on International law and sea level rise after twelve years. The roundtable will provide an opportunity to discuss sea level rise issues facing small island developing states, a presentation of the 7<sup>th</sup> X.Y.D.O.X.V. '0-Report on Resilient and Sustainable Development and adaptation models. The co-chairs of the International Law Commission Study Group (SG) on Sea Level Rise in relation to international law will be able to provide a briefing on the progress made to date. In addition, the conclusions of the final report of the ILA Committee on International Law and Sea Level Rise (I.L.A. Y.H.O. 5 L.V.H. Z.K.L.F.K. F.R.P. S.I.Q.W.I.P.H. Q.W.V. W.K. presented and discussed.
