The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova to the United Nations, in its compliments to ... and with reference to Note Verbale LA/COD/4 of 20 June 2022 and General Assembly Resolution 75/129 of 15 December 2020, which contains the text of the measures to "enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives" has the honour to inform on the following:

In summer 2020, it was revealed that the premises of the Russian Federation Embassy in Chisinau had been invaded. In response, Moldovan competent authorities promptly undertook all the required measures. The specialized services, upon verification of the adjacent territory, visited the premises of the Embassy. However, no security breaches were identified. Further investigations by competent authorities have established that the criminal case initiated on the stated facts is currently closed. The materials provided have not been sufficient to identify the perpetrators.

On 11 August 2020, a team of the Ministry of Interior was deployed on site for the following a call received by the National Emergency Call 112 reporting a threat to the Embassy of the Russian Federation in Chisinau. At the moment, the examination of this case was suspended.

Since 24 February 2022, the General Inspectorate of Carabineers has increased the security and public order measures for all foreign diplomatic missions. In Chisinau, a special protection regime has been set up for the Embassy of the Russian Federation due to the increased number of demonstrations organized by different civic movements. As a measure for security, the Carabineers maintain contact with the designated representative of the Embassy of the Russian Federation in order to coordinate the activities of diplomatic missions and protect the Embassy's premises. In the incidents occurred during the demonstrations, contravention measures have been applied.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova would like to assure that the Moldovan authorities are committed and take all appropriate measures to ensure the protection, security and safety of all diplomatic and consular missions and representatives, including measures of a preventive nature, complying with the applicable rules of international law.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova to the United Nations kindly requests the inclusion of the above-mentioned information in the Security Council report on the agenda item "Consolidation of Confidence-Building Measures to Enhance the Protection, Security and Safety of Diplomatic and Consular Missions and Representatives".
