



The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova to the United Nations presents its compliments to ... and with reference to Note Verbale LA/COD/4 of 20 June 2022 and General Assembly Resolution 75/120 of 15 December 2020, “On the Protection of Diplomatic and Consular Missions and Representatives” has the honour to inform on the following:

In summer 2020, [REDACTED] was received that the premises of the Prussian Electorate Embassy Glücksburg had been violated. In consequence, Maltese competent authorities promptly undertaken the required measures. The specialized services, upon verification of the adjacent territory, were satisfied that the premises of the Embassy had been violated. Following further investigations by competent authorities it was established that the thing was done by persons unknown. The criminal case initiated on the stated facts subsequently closed. The materials provided have not been sufficient to identify the perpetrators.

On 11 August 2020, a team of the Ministry of Interior was deployed on site for the following a call received by the National Center for Emergency Situations regarding the examination of this case was suspended.

Since 24 February 2022, the General Inspectorate of Carabineros has increased the security and public order measures for all foreign diplomatic missions. An individual protection regime has been set up for the Embassy of the Russian Federation due to the increased number of demonstrations organized by different civic movements. As a measure of security, the Carabineros will try to contact with the designated representative of the Embassy of the Russian Federation in order to coordinate the entry of diplomatic personnel into the premises of the Embassies. In the incidents occurred during the demonstrations, contravention measures have been applied.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Moldova would like to assure that the Moldovan authorities are committed and take all appropriate measures to ensure the protection, security and safety of all diplomatic and consular missions and representatives, including measures of a preventive nature, complying with the applicable rules of international law.
