5. The Third Committee reaffirms section B, paragraph 9, of the annex to resolution [58/126](#), which stipulates, inter alia, that the Bureau should be elected three months in advance of the next session in order to foster better advance planning and preparation of the work. The Bureau-elect will meet immediately after its election to discuss the organization and division of the work as well as to consider the programme of work of the Committee. With a view to ensuring the continuity and the effective organization of its work, the incoming Bureau will continue to meet with the outgoing Bureau to consult on and review issues relating to the efficient functioning of the Committee.

6. The Committee also wishes to continue its recent practice of dividing among the Vice-Chairs and the Rapporteur the Bureau's responsibility for monitoring draft resolutions emanating from their respective regional groups. The Bureau and the

Owing to the large number of informal consultations on the draft resolutions tabled in the Committee, the Bureau and delegations have expressed concern at the lack of availability of rooms and secretariat support for the consultations, which can hamper the timely conclusion of the Committee's work. Meeting rooms at the Secretariat building should also be made available for consultations.
