

United Nations Special Adviser on the Prevention of Genocide expresses alarm at public comments by Philippines President Rodrigo Duterte

(New York, 30 September 2016) The Special Adviser on the Prevention of Genocide, Adama Diarra, expressed alarm at public comments by President Rodrigo Duterte of the Philippines, in which he reportedly forced a campaign to kill millions of drug addicts in the Philippines and compared it to the massacre of millions of Jews by Hitler during the Holocaust in Nazi Germany in the 1940s.

Adama Diarra condemned such a statement as deeply disrespectful.
