

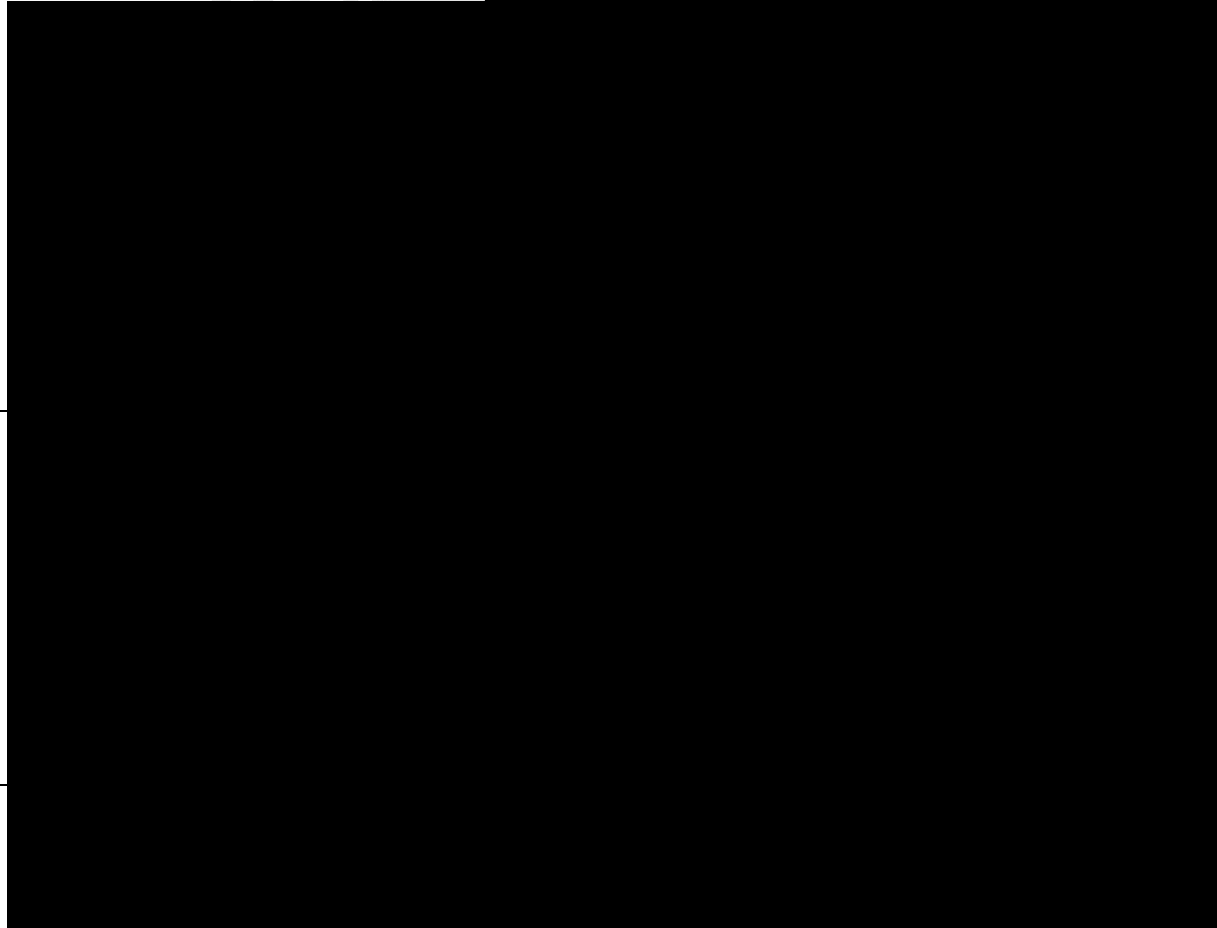


Judgment
