

## JDEGAEECA, PED

1. Marius Russo-Got, formerly with the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS), contested before the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT or Dispute Tribunal) the Respondent's decision to abolish his post and not to renew his fixed term agreement (FTA). The UNDT's first Judgment (UNDT/2020/072 delivered on 13 May 2020) decided that Mr. Russo-Got's challenge to the abolition of post was not receivable because it had not been the subject of a timely request for management evaluation, but that his claim concerning the non-renewal of his FTA was receivable. In a subsequent Judgment No. UNDT/2020/088 delivered on 16 June 2020, the UNDT determined that, while receivable, his separate challenge to non-renewal failed on its merits. Mr. RussoeGot appeals against both judgments.
