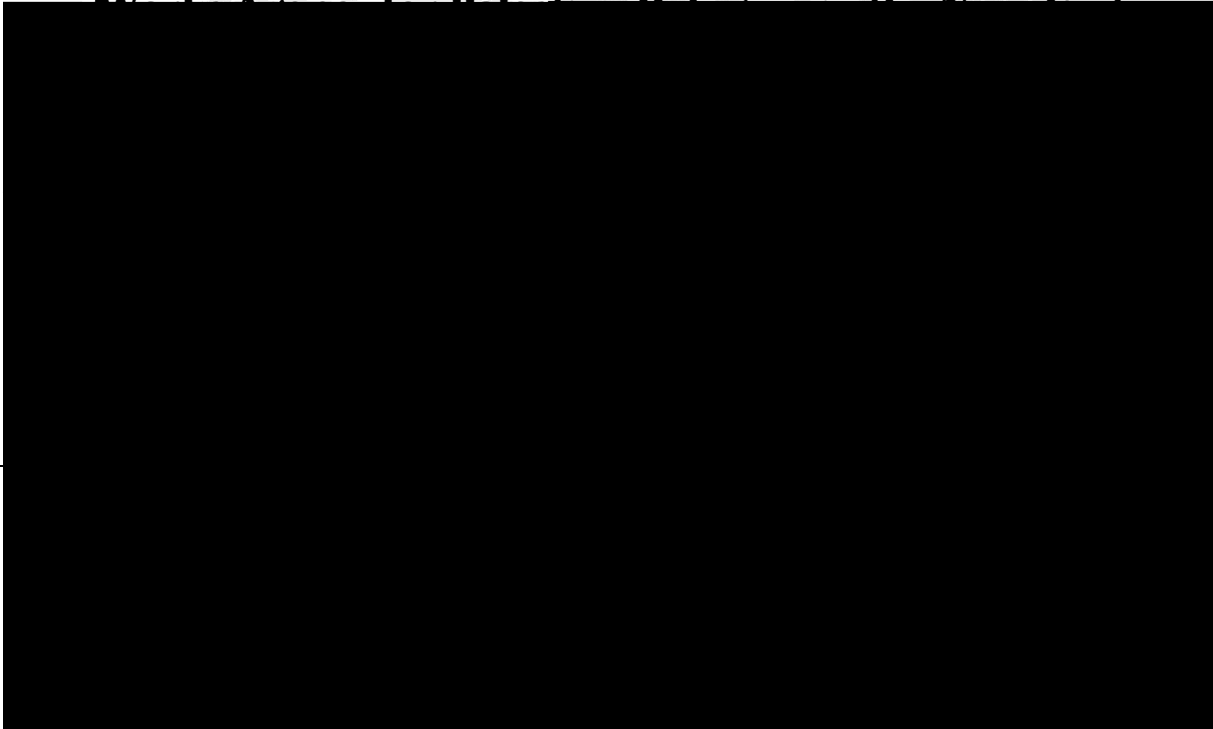

**COMMISSIONER-GENERAL'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION TO FILE AN
ANSWER**

1. On 10 December 2010, the Registry of the United Nations Appeals Tribunal transmitted an appeal by Mohammad Diab Al Sayyed (Al Sayyed) to the UNRWA Commissioner-General, who received it on 13 December 2010. Under article 9 (3) of the Rules of Procedure of the Appeals Tribunal, the Respondent has 45 days within which to file an Answer, i.e., by 27 January 2011.

2. Under cover of an email dated 24 January 2011, the Commissioner-General requests extension of the time limit to file an answer by eight calendar days to 4 February 2011. The Commissioner-General explains that his representative must travel urgently to Beirut through the week of 24-28 January and to Amman early during the week of 31

ORDER

5. For the foregoing reasons, I decide to grant the Commissioner-General's request for extension of eight calendar days until 4 February 2011 for filing an Answer. I instruct the Registry to attach a copy of this Order to UNRWA's Answer, if any.
