3. Pursuant to Article 7(1)(c) of the Statute of the Appeals Tribunal (Statute), an appeal must be filed within 60 days of the receipt of the judgment of the UNRWA Dispute Tribunal. Furthermore, pursuant to Article 11(5) of the Statute of the UNRWA Dispute Tribunal "the applicant shall also receive a copy translated into Arabic if the

application was submitted in Arabic¹ Accordingly, the time limit for filing an appeal in this case expired on 24 April 2012.

4. I have considered Mr. Ashour's request and do not believe that his request constitutes an exceptional case warranting an extension of the time limit as provided for by our Statute.

4. For the foregoing reason, I deny Mr. Ashour's request and order that his appeal, if any, is due by 25 May 2012.
