

4. In an email to the Registry dated 14 May 2013, the Counsel apologized and asked for three weeks so as to permit him to "complete the listing of annexes and the provision of the appropriate documents".

5. Having reviewed the case file, I have decided not to grant the latest request. The Appeals Tribunal expects parties and counsel to take the instructions from the Registry

seriously and act upon them diligently so as to assist it in the discharge of its mandate. On 29 April 2013, Counsel filed an application for revision on behalf of Mr. Al-Mulla. On 1 May 2013, the Registry asked Counsel to cure the defects in the application by *inter alia* submitting the documents as annexes. On the same day, Counsel informed the Registry to expect to hear from him the next day. However, he did not do so. Neither did he provide any explanation. In my view, Counsel had sufficient time to perfect Mr. Al-Mulla's application, but failed to take action in a diligent and responsible manner.

6. Mr. Al-Mulla's request for additional time to submit annexes is hereby rejected. His application for revision should be processed as is.
