

Neither the Statute nor the Rules of Procedure of the Appeals Tribunal (Rules) provides for an appellant to submit any pleadings other than those set forth in the Rules. Articles 8 and 9 of the Rules provide for an appellant to file an appeal form and an accompanying appeals brief, and for a respondent to submit an answer

form and an accompanying answer brief. Nevertheless, the Appeals Tribunal

has ruled that under Article 31(1) of the Rules, additional pleadings may be allowed in

"exceptional circumstances".1

5. In the present case, Mr. Chahrour has not provided any reasons specific to his case which would amount to "exceptional circumstances" to allow the filing of an additional

pleading or rejoinder to the answer.

For the foregoing reason, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Chahrour's motion for leave to

file a rejoinder IS DENIED.
