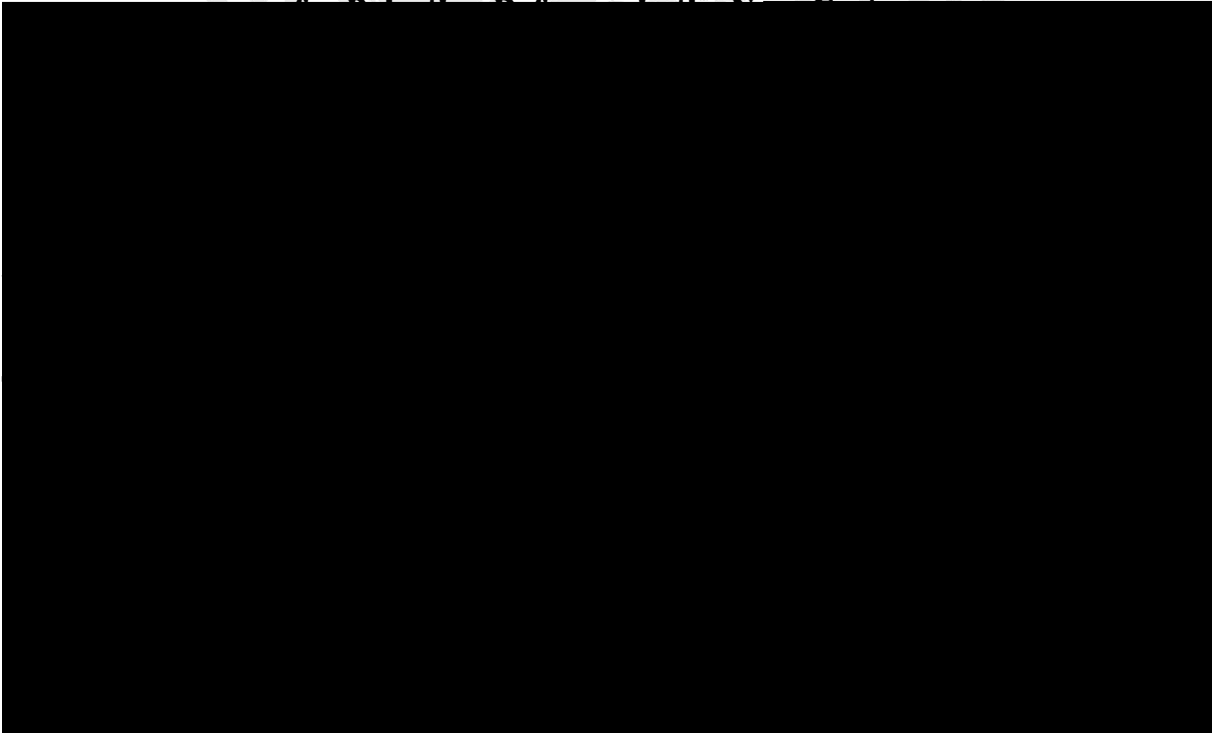

I am satisfied that it is in the interests of justice to suspend the time limit for the filing of an appeal in this case, which I consider to be exceptional within the meaning of Article 7(3) of the Statute of the Appeals Tribunal, until such time as the interpretation of judgment is handed down.¹
