

- 3. On 2 November 2017, Mr. Kawamleh filed a motion seeking leave to file additional pleadings in response to the Commissioner-General's answer to his appeal. On 10 November 2017, the Commissioner-General filed his response opposing the motion.
- 4. Under the Appeals Tribunal Statute, Mr. Kawamleh is not entitled to file a

doing so.¹ However, Mr. Kawamleh has not demonstrated the existence of exceptional circumstances; he merely seeks to supplement his appeal. Thus, Mr. Kawamleh's motion for leave to file additional pleadings is denied.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Kawamleh's motion IS DENIED.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that the Registrar shall not include the motion as well as the Secretary-General's response thereto in the case file.
