3. On 2 November 2017, Mr. Kawamleh filed a motion seeking leave to file additional pleadings in response to the Commissioner-General's answer to his appeal. On 10 November 2017, the Commissioner-General filed his response opposing the motion.

4. Under the Appeals Tribunal Statute, Mr. Kawamleh is not entitled to file a

doing so.¹ However, Mr. Kawamleh has not demonstrated the existence of exceptional circumstances; he merely seeks to supplement his appeal. Thus, Mr. Kawamleh's motion for leave to file additional pleadings is denied.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Kawamleh's motion IS DENIED .

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that the Registrar shall not include the motion as well as the Secretary-General's response thereto in the case file.
