1. On 25 October 2018, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Geneva rendered Judgment No. UNDT/2018/106 in the case of Kinyanjui v. Secretary-General of the United Nations

written request for a waiver of a time limit, and Article 30 of the Rules allows this Tribunal to shorten or extend a time limit "when the interests of justice so require".

4. On the basis of Mr. Kinyanjui's statement about the difficult circumstances that he faced in connection with his wife's pregnancy and the birth of his children, this Tribunal finds that Mr. Kinyanjui has presented an exceptional case and the interests of justice will be served if his request is granted so as to give him an opportunity to present his case.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Kinyanjui's request for a waiver of time limit and
