ORDER No. 474 (20 22)

1. On 1 June 2022, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) in Geneva rendered Judgment No. UNDT/2022/054 in the case of Krioutchkov v the Secretary-General of the United Nations, rejecting Mr. Krioutchkov's application contesting the decision not to select him for a P-4 post of Russian Reviser, with the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management in New York.
2. On 29 July 2022, Mr. Krioutchkov filed an appeal with the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal or UNAT). The case is yet to be set down for hearing.

5. On 9 September 2022, the Secretary General submitted his response, indicating that he had no objections to Mr. Krioutchkov's motion for withdrawal .

6. The Appeals Tribunal has consistently held that "a party may withdraw an appeal simply by giving notice and need not necessarily provide any further justification". ¹
