- 1. On 4 March 2010, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) issued Order No. 21 (GVA/2010), requesting the United Nations Office of Internal Oversight Services to submit information related to an investigation no later than by Monday 8 March 2010, EOB.
- 2. At the moment of the issuance of the present order, Order No. 21 (GVA/2010) had not been complied with.
- 3. Article 9, paragraph 1, of the UNDT statute provides that "The Dispute Tribunal may order production of documents or such other evidence as it deems necessary" and that article 10, paragraph 8, of the UNDT statute stipulates that "The Dispute Tribunal may refer appropriate cases to the Secretary-General of the United Nations or the executive heads of separately administered United Nations funds and programmes for possible action to enforce accountability".
- 4. The Tribunal recalls that any staff member, irrespective of his or her position within the Organisation, who refuses to comply with an order issued by the Tribunal can be personally held responsible; and

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Under-Secretary-General for Internal Oversight Services submit the information requested in Order No. 21 (GVA/2010) by no later than **Tuesday**, **9 March 2010**, **EOB**.
