1. By a decision filed on 13 June 2017, the Arbitral Tribunal re-examined the findings of the Commission's investigation into the alleged irregularities in the procurement process for the construction of the D'Arcaud (United Nations) Research Station (UNID12) in Antarctica in 2014-15.
