

1. By Order no. 161 (A/01) of 3 November 2011, the Tribunal ordered, *inter alia*, that the proceedings before the Tribunal ~~under Order No. D/A/019/046~~ be suspended until 3 February 2011, or the date the Appellant's treating physician orders him fit to work or his rejoinder, whichever is earlier; and that the Appellant's request be extended beyond 3 February 2011, and a prompt written determination of his extension.

2. On 3 February 2011, the Appellant filed a submission pursuant to Order no. 161 (A/01), requesting an extension of time for the filing of his rejoinder.
