Introduction

1. The Applicant is challenging the administrative decisions by the UNtetions Office for Project Services (UNOPS) to both deny him separatione fits and violate his confidentiality by the alleged publication of his name antegoly prejudicial statement about the nature of his complaint.

Background

2. The parties were amenable to hav**ing** matter resolved by way of mediation and as such the Tribunal on 21 September 2012 is **Grater** No.: 123 (NBI/2012) referring the matter to the Mediation Division in the Office of the United Nations Ombudsman and Mediation Services a period of thirty days.

3. On 17 October 2012, the Regional Ombudsman for Geneva requested an extension of time of one month whi**dh**e Tribunal granted on 18 October 2012 by issuing Order No.: 133 (NBI/2012) which suspended the proceedings until 21 November 2012.

By letter dated 19 November 2012, the pirector of Mediation Service, Mediation Division in the Office of the United Nations Ombudsman and Mediation Services sought another extigents of time for a period of hirty days in which to complete the mediation. The Tribunal granted the extensio Ortolger No.: 151 (NBI/2012).

5. On 27 November 2012, the Applicant informed the Registryemail that an amicable agreement had been reached the advector wanted towithdraw his case. Consequently, he filed a motion with adving the Application on 18 December 2012.

7. The matter of *Claus v. the Secretary-General* of *the United Nations*, registered as case number UNDT/NEGH 0/035 be struck off the record.
