8. By email on 6 November 2012, the Mediation Division requested a twomonth extension of time for the mediatiton move forward. The Tribunal granted the request for extension by Order Not42 (NBI/2012) on 9 November 2012 and accordingly suspended the proceedifogs two months, until 9 January 2013.

9. By letter to the Tribunal on <sup>th</sup>9 January 2013, the Mediation Division requested another extension of time un<sup>th</sup>IlF9ebruary 2013 for the mediation to be completed.

10. Article 15.5 of the Tribunal's Rules **of** rocedure provides that the time limit for mediation normally shallot exceed three months.

11. On 11 January 2013, the Tribunal issocrited results No. 006 (NBI/2013) granting a suspension of the proceedings up until 11 February 2013.

12. On 18 February 2013, the **Fles** filed an aplication for extension of the deadline for mediation. The Parties informulate the Tribunal that progress had been made and that the request for extension to assettle the specificos of the settlement.

13. In Order No. 042 (NBI/2013) issued **20** February 2013, the Tribunal noted that the informal settlement of the matter is of priority to both parties and reminded them of the need to each an amicable settlement source nas possible and within the prescribed time. The Tribunal stated through tinual applications for suspension of proceedings with no progress may amount to abuse of process and granted a final extension of time for settlement. The proceedings in the instant case were suspended up to 14 March 2013.

14. On 7 March 2013, Ms Deborah Mendez, Dottoer of Mediation, Office of the United Nations Ombudsman and MediaticServices informed the Tribunal, informally, that this case was settled in material and would send threefficial letter in due course.

15. On 21 March 2013, Ms Mendez informedet Thribunal formally that due to the good faith efforts of all parties, threatter had been settled in mediation.

16. On 26 March 2013, the Applicant notifielde Tribunal that having resolved the matter informally; he wishes to twidtraw his Application in its entirety.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

17. In light of the above, there is nonlger any matter for adjudication by the Dispute Tribunal.

18. The matter of *Gballah v. the Secretary-General of the United Nations*, registered in our records as case nembNDT/NBI/2012/002 be struck off the record.
