- 1. The Applicant served as a Movement Cotrol Assistant at the United Nations Mission in the Republic of South Sudan ("UNMISSE) letter dated 24 September 2014 was separated from service with compensation in lieu of notice and without termination indemnity for serious misconduct. By Application on his behalf by one Abdalla Alfadroif Counsel, dated 26 November 2014 he challenge the decision to separate him from service.
- 2. The Respondent filed Reply to the Application on December 2014.
- 3. Vide Order No. 108 (NBI/2015) duly served on both Parties the said Parties were required to attend a case management discussion process of a fair and expeditious disposal of the calse ither the Applicant nor his Counsel attended the case management discussion put in a representation at the case management discussion.
- 4. On 20 April 2015, the Tribunal issue@order No. 121 (NBI/2015), scheduling the case for a hearing on the merits fre@mSeptember 2016 om 1400 hours In the said Order

- 8. The Tribunal convened to hear the case at 1400 hours Nairobi time on 8 September 2015 as scheduled. Between 1400 and 1500 hours, several attempts were made to contact the Applicant and his Counsel via telephone to participate in the hearingThe telephone connectin was disconnected soon after initial contacts lasting several seconds.
- 9. At 1750 hourson 8 September 2015 he Applicant using the same email address that the Registry has been using to communicate with the mail indicating a telphone number only as the contents
