## Introduction

- 1. On 28 Septembe 2015, the Applicant an FS4 Finance Assistant in the United Nations Mission in Liberia (UNMIL), filed an Application with the Dispute Tribunal seeking suspension of implementation of the decision not to renew hisappointment beyond 30 September 2015
- 2. The Respondent filed his Reply on 30 Septem 2015
- 3. On 30 September 2015, the Tribunal granted the Application for suspension of action and informed the Parties that a reasoned order would be issued by Friday, 2 October 2015.

- 4. The Applicant joined the UnitedNations in 2009.He held a fixed term contract at the FS4 level as Finance Assistant, which expired 30 June 2015
- 5. Following the expiry of his employment contract, the Applicant sought a suspension of action of the decision not to extend his contact be not do not be considered by the Tribunal, UNMIL Administration of the Applicant a-Boonthextension of his contract.

On 30 June 2015 pursuant to the Tribunal's directiothe Respondent filed further submissions darify UNMIL Administration's position These further submissions showed that the Applicant's extension conftract beyond 30 June 2015 would be for three months only and that the extension of all posts at the mission through 30 June 2016 would not applinitm.
- 7. The Management Evaluation Unit (MEU) issued a moot letter in response to the Applicant's first request for management evaluation basedUNdMIL's extension of his contract.
- 8. On 10 July 2015 the Applicant filed an application with the Tribunal contesting three decisions:
